The Associated Students of Cañada College By Law Committee Stipend Policy allows for students who attend district and campus committee meetings to receive an \$18.00 stipend to be paid from the Student Representation Fee. Eligibility:

- 1) Be currently enrolled in at least 6 units or 1 class & have completed at least 24 units at Cañada College
- 2) Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.00 in course work completed in the San Mateo County Community College District (SMCCCD)

Representative Responsibilities:

- 1) Attend an orientation session with the Coordinator of Student Activities and/or the Committee Chairperson.
- 2) Attend all meetings and maintain a binder (provided by ASCC) which shall include all agenda, minutes and all other materials pertaining to the committee.
- 3) File a written synopsis of each meeting with an attached agenda to the ASCC secretary within 5 school days.
- 4) Attend Senate meetings &/or Executive Board meetings to give a verbal report as requested by the AS President and Vice President.
- 5) Recommend positions, actions and strategies to the Student Senate and/or the Executive Board
- 6) Notify the Coordinator of Student Activities and the ASCC president if unable to attend an assigned committee meeting for any reason.
 - a. Make arrangements for an alternative representative when possible.
