## Information for Parents

You will be responsible for transportation to and from the University for your son/daughter. Arriving time is set for Sunday, July 10, 2011 between 3:00 and 4:00 PM. However, you should plan on spending at least 3 hours in the University that day. There will be an orientation and welcoming session for the students with their parents, followed by a tour of the University campus, between 5:15 and 5:45 PM. It is important that you stay for the orientation session since information will be provided in regard to the overall program. The information will include but not be limited to: the activities that the students will be engaging in during the two weeks, how to get in touch with the students in case of emergency, activities that you are invited to participate in, and other relevant information. This session will also give you an opportunity to meet some of the professionals that will be teaching and/or chaperoning your son/daughter. Please review the Opening Day Program included in this package. Since the space is limited only two family members will be allowed at the orientation and welcoming session. Please bring the enclosed tickets, as they will be collected at the door.

The students will be housed in the campus dormitories “SFSU Village at Centennial Square” and all meals will be provided at the “City Eats” restaurant on campus. Adult supervision will be enforced at all times. Strict conduct rules are established for the students and they are enclosed for your review. We will review these rules during the orientation session.

On Sunday, July 17, there will be a barbecue at the San Francisco University softball field. You may accompany your son/daughter that day, however, you will need to provide your own transportation. More details on this field trip will be provided at the orientation session.

The last day of the institute includes student project presentations, an award ceremony and a lunch buffet. Parents are invited to attend this final day program. However, since space is limited, the number of family members attending the award ceremony and lunch buffet will be limited to three people per student. Three tickets per student will be provided during registration to attend the award ceremony and lunch buffet. Checkout will follow the lunch buffet.
