

Information for the Student

Upon arriving to the university campus on July 10, 2011, you will be provided with a package containing the entire program. You will be responsible for getting familiar with the program and for knowing where you need to be at all times during the institute. You will be guided to the university dormitories, where a room will be assigned to you.

During the two weeks of the institute you will engage in various activities, including classroom work, field work, sport activities, and social activities. We encourage you to bring adequate clothing for all these activities. Also, remember that San Francisco summer weather is unpredictable.

You will not be allowed to carry a cellular phone during the institute, use of all phones including the campus public phones will only be allowed during personal time. However, information will be provided during the orientation and welcome session for dealing with telephone calls during emergencies.

The complete agenda for the first day is included in this package, please review it prior to arriving to the university.

Everything you need for working on the project will be provided to you, there is no need to bring any school material.

You will be assigned a roommate for the dorm. Make sure you meet your roommate the first day and establish some ground rules within the living space that you will share.

The last day of the program includes a student presentation of your project in front of a panel of judges. We advise that you bring a professional outfit for that day as it is customary that most students dress up for that event.
