	admission to UCI. Those 6 are ones we nominated for the Honors to Honors Program,
	which is a higher level. Anyone in our program can be nominated for this but for this 6 it
	is guaranteed admission.
•	Rebekah reported that 3 HTP students were accepted to present at <u>WRHC</u> on March 29

•	New Completion Form-streamlined process where faculty receive a copy and email
	when students submit with a request to approve or not. Rebekah will have a list of

students who submit and faculty who approve and can easily remind them via formstack.

- <u>New HTP Application Form</u>-This includes the new challenge application for students who are very close but not quite eligible for the program to complete a supplemental couple of paragraphs. Recently, we had a student with a 3.2 GPA successfully complete the challenge application indicating that the need to care for a very ill close family member temporarily impacted their GPA.
- <u>New Intent to Transfer Form</u>-asks students when they plan to apply and transfer and where. got 40 respondents so far. This has helped us to capture who is applying to UCLA and UCI and complete the following tasks:
 - Notify UCI of students on track to complete honors program.
 - Certify eligible students to UCLA for priority admission

Rebekah shared that we tested all the above forms but need member feedback

Contract Forms

- Importance of clarity around contract requirements. Michael mentioned that before students submit the contract proposal they need to be aware of the process and need to communicate with and get approval from their contract professor prior. Rebekah showed where in the new form it describes this process and asks the student if they have their professor's approval and then to click to verify that. The completion form at the end also repeats these guidelines and checks in with the professor again.
- Need student communication with Honors professor during contracts
- Rebekah said professors will be copied on Student's contract proposal submission
- One incident of proposal email not going through. This is being investigated. Other 16+ went through.

Application Form

- Gloria asked to add a reminder to include a high school transcript if they have one and have completed less than 9 units of credit here. Need to update to include CSU colleges as well.
- Gampi noted the importance of awareness of HTP eligibility requirements. Rebekah explained that these are stated in the form and on the website. She invited feedback on the honors transfer program website and Canvas shell, with a focus on improving eligibility criteria and user experience.
- There was some confusion between the application and the honors contract page and Rebekah clarified the difference and explained where information was for each
- Students can choose Honors courses and/or Honors Contracts, allowing students to choose their path.

Supporting Contract and Honors Faculty Workgroup Progress

- A PD Resource Request was made and will get reviewed this semester to start in fall if accepted. The purpose is to support Honors Contract faculty and for veteran honors contract faculty to train new Honors contract faculty. Honors faculty will be able to collaborate on strategies for helping honors students complete quality projects on time. Faculty will be paid for reported meetings with honors contract students

- Susan mentioned encouraging students who do contracts to take IDST 150 Honors Research Seminar to get support.
- Sarah wrote in chat that some support in Llbrary 100 as well
- Gampi (via chat) asked if workload points vary by division/dean interpretation
- Rebekah said Hum. & SS and other divisions give points for contracts and it seems to be spreading-everyone reach out to your deans and divisions and advocate for this
- Sarah (via chat): only full time faculty not adjunct faculty can do independent studies
- Gloria (via chat): Need to make sure students know that independent studies do not transfer to UCs
