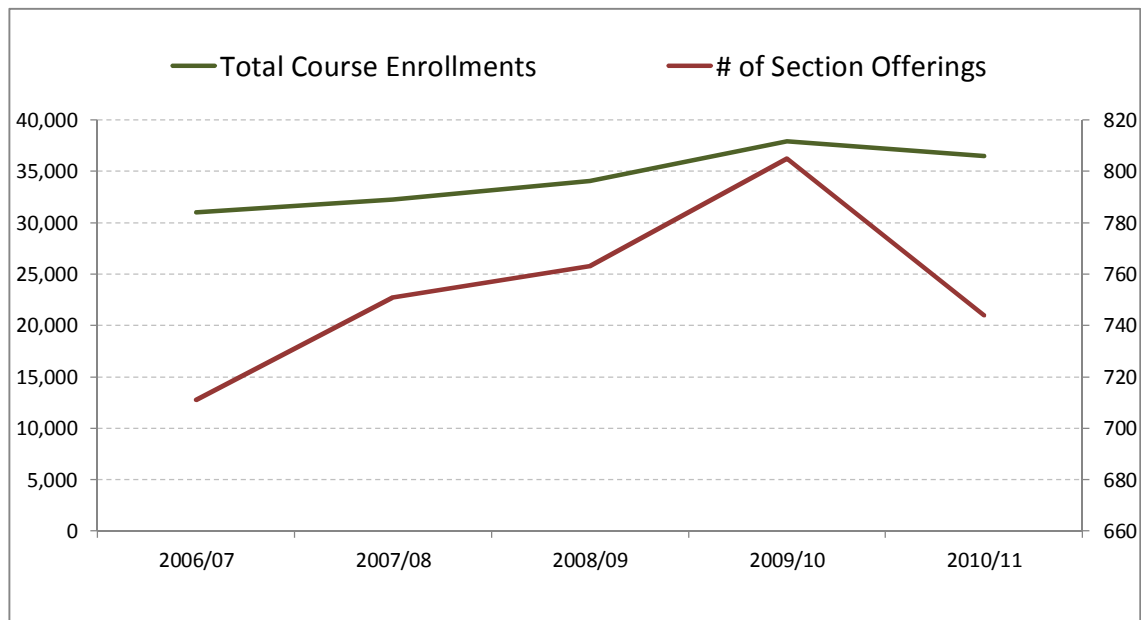

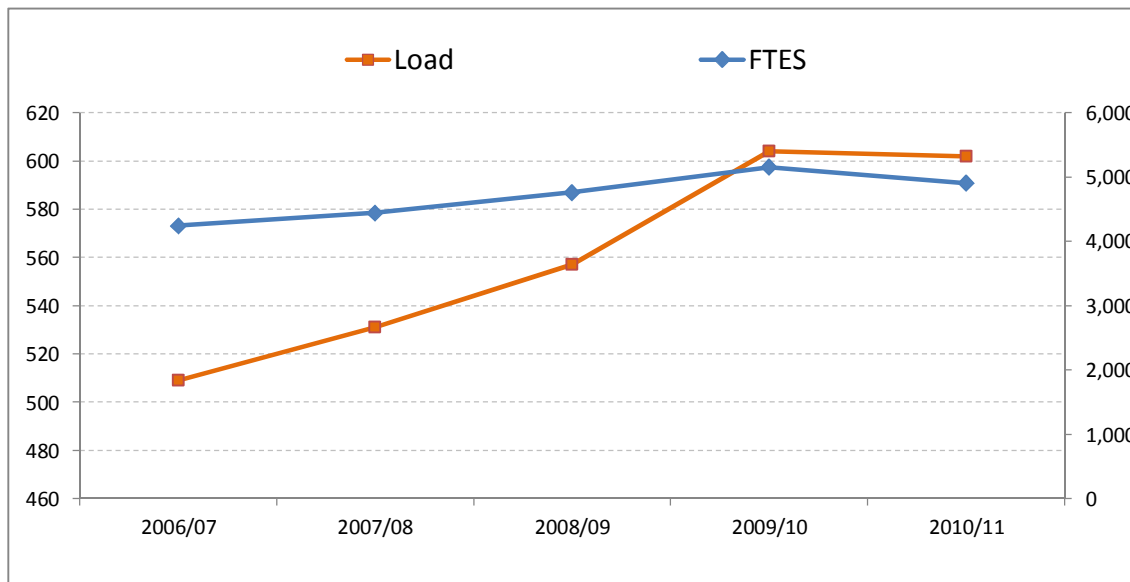

Load is the ratio of WSCH to FTE and a standard measure of department efficiency.



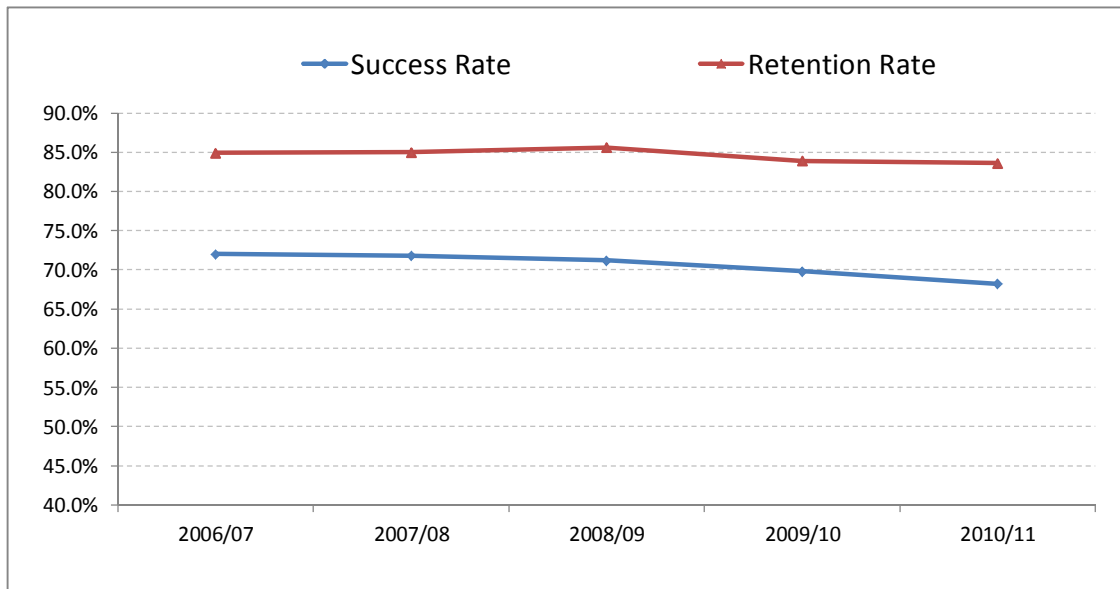

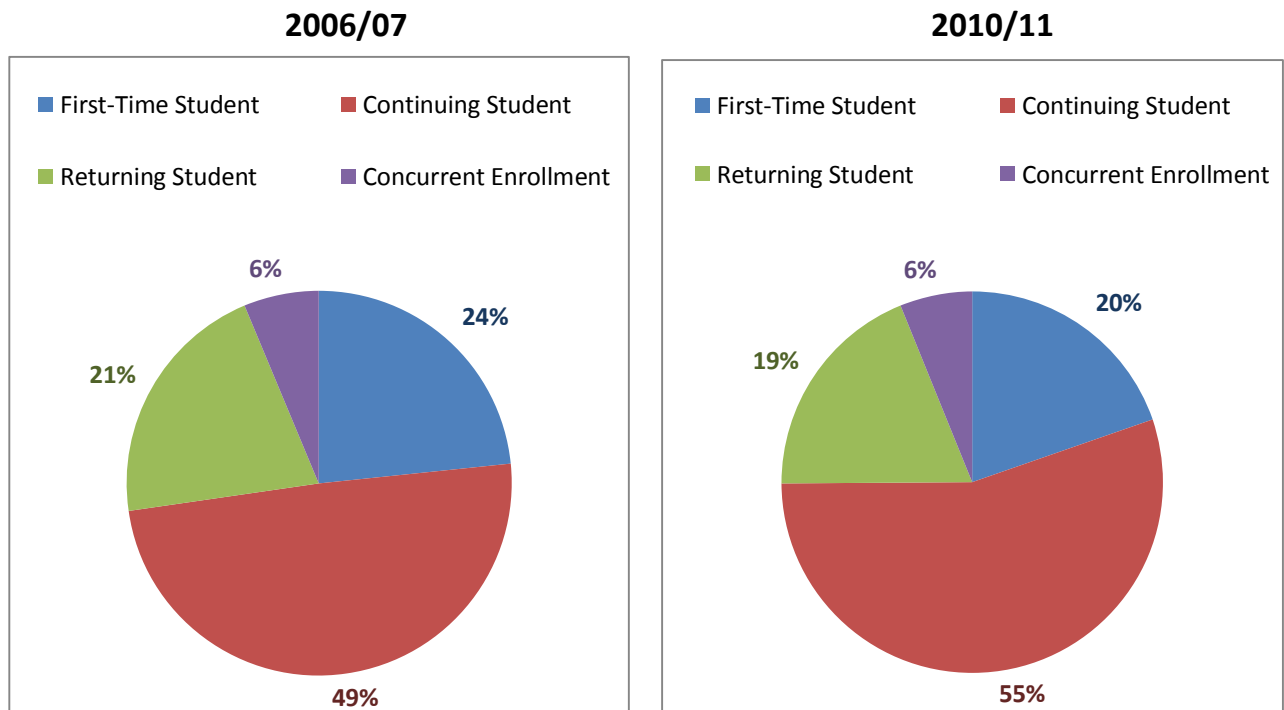

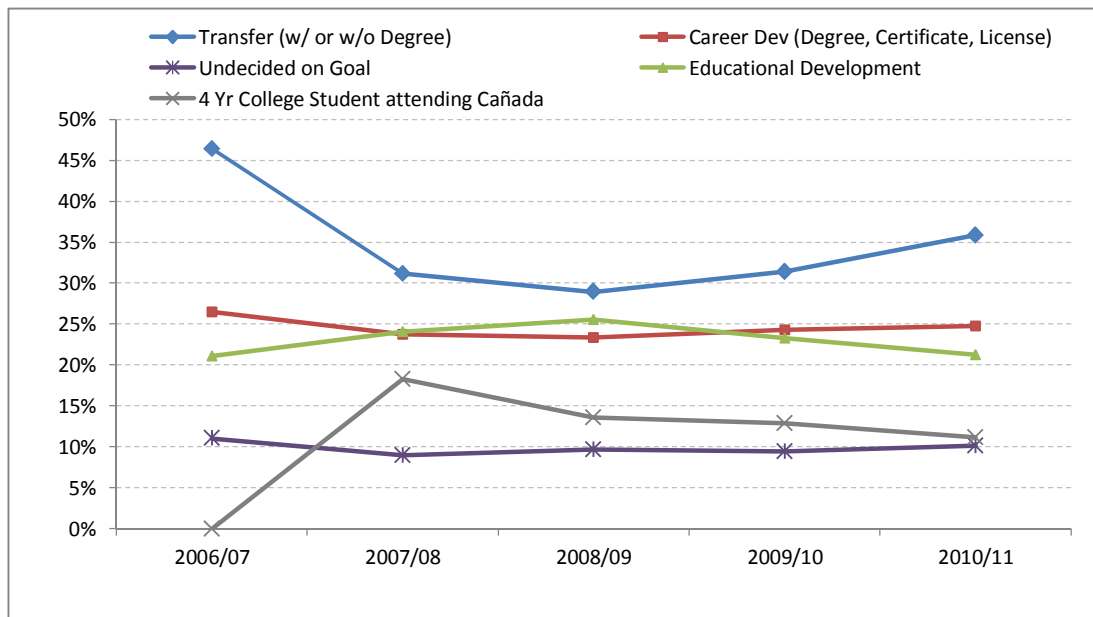

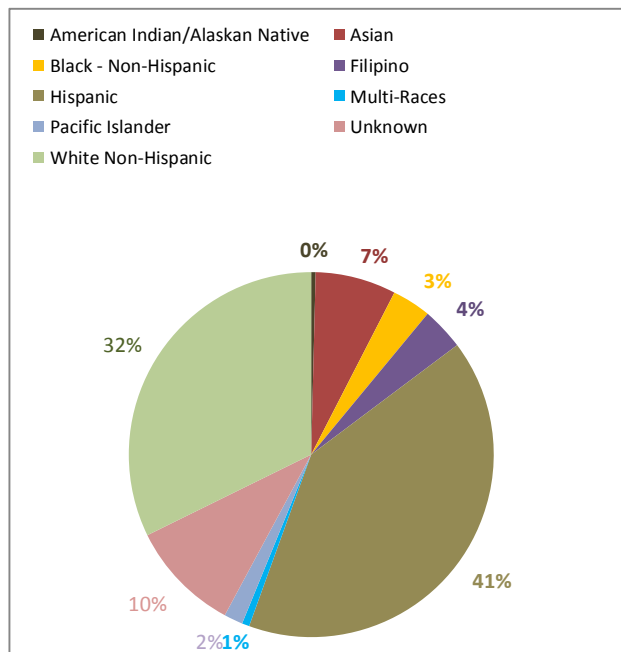

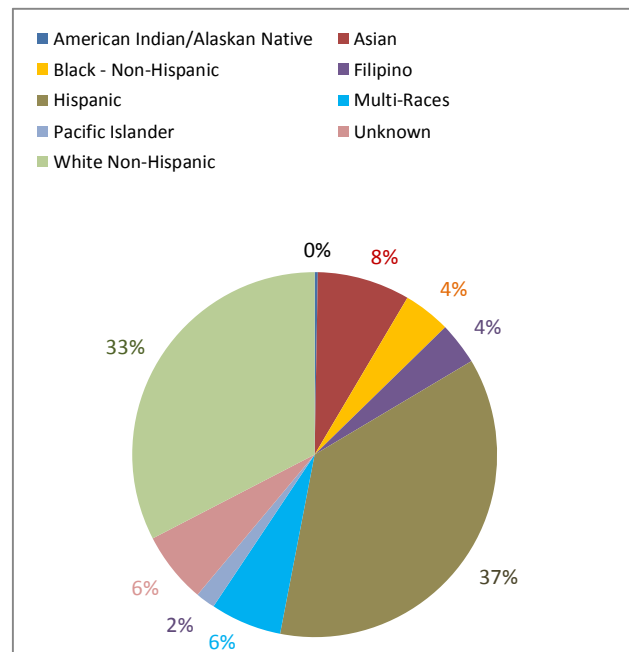
