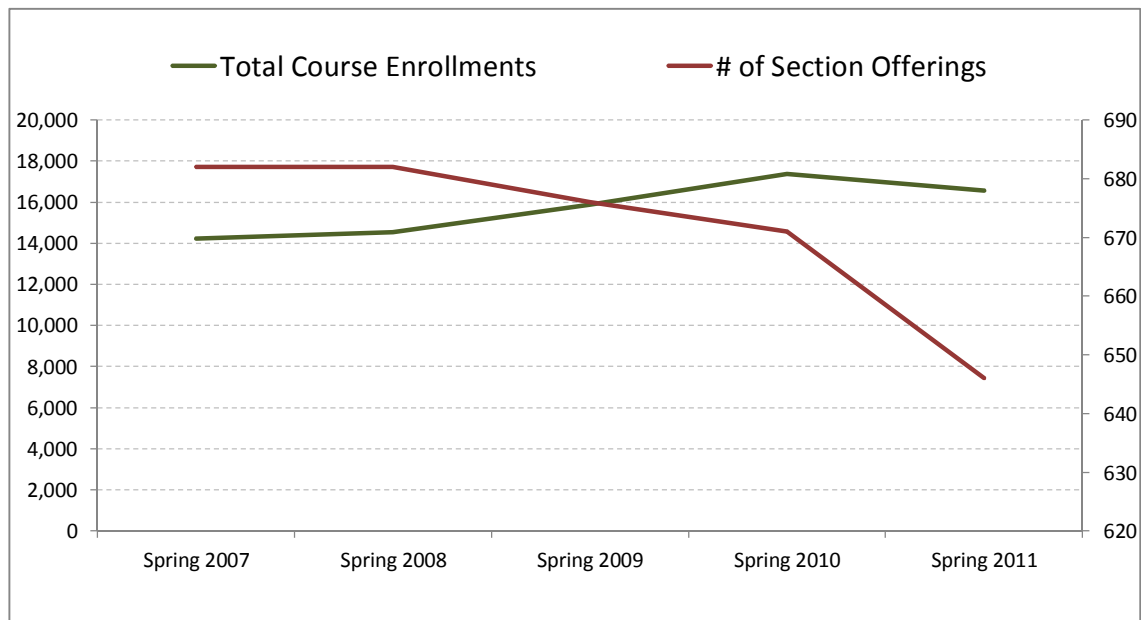
**Data Definitions:** **Unique Headcount** is the count of individual students (no duplicates) enrolled at the college

**Ave Enrollment per Section** is the average number of students per section (Average Class Size).

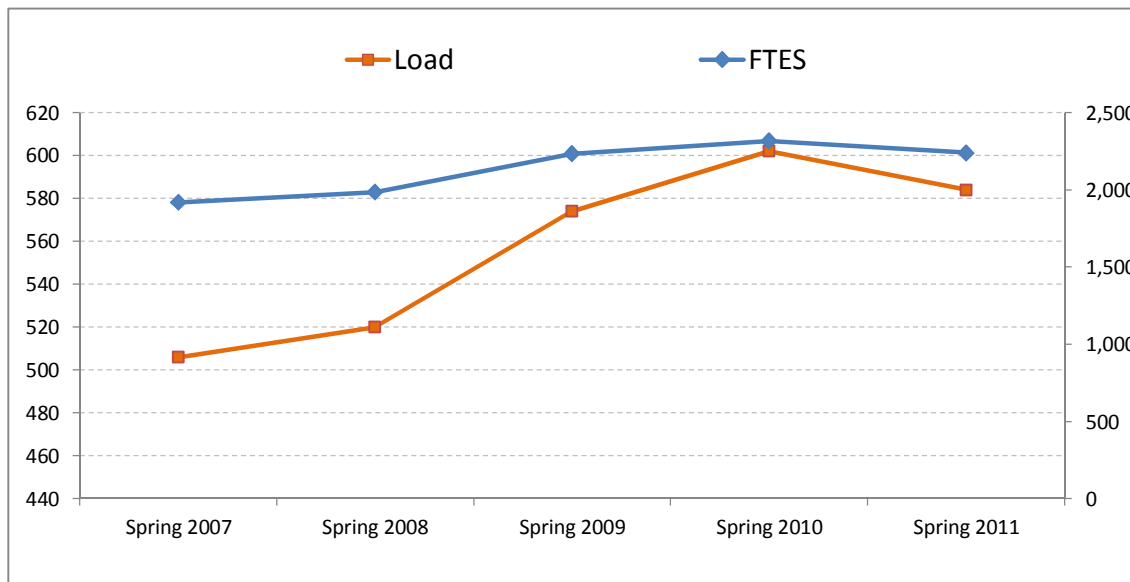

**Load** is the ratio of WSCH to FTE and a standard measure of department efficiency.



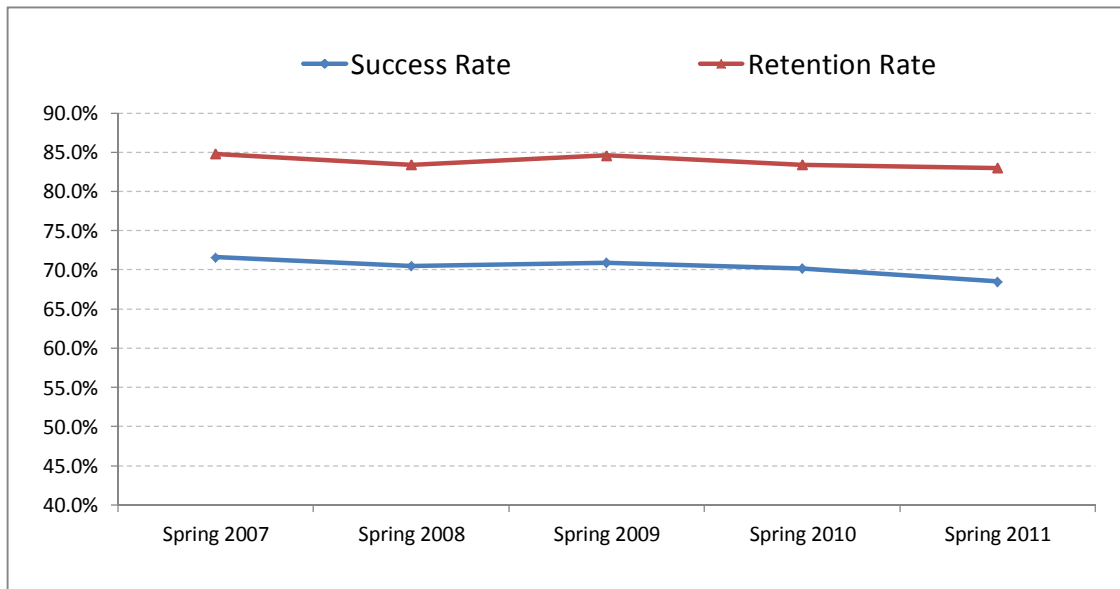

**Ave Term GPA** is the average current term GPA of all students taking courses in the College for the given term.  
**Ave Cumulative GPA** is the average cumulative GPA of all students taking courses in the College for the given term.

### Student Performance Profile



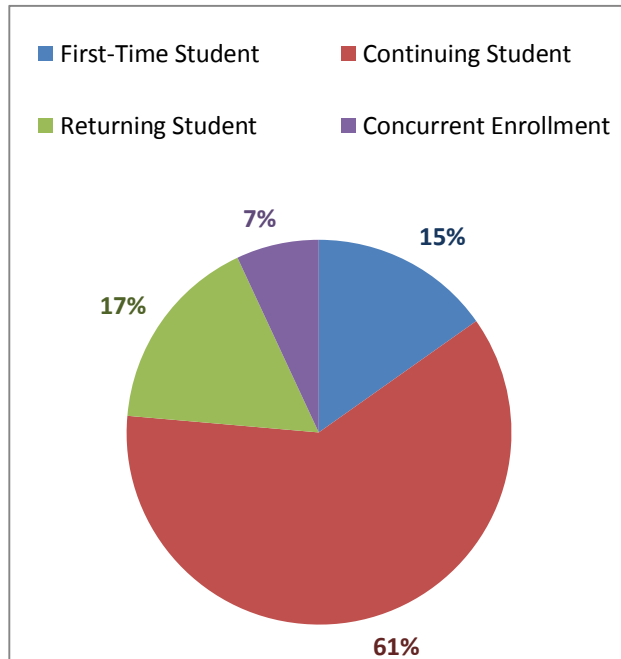

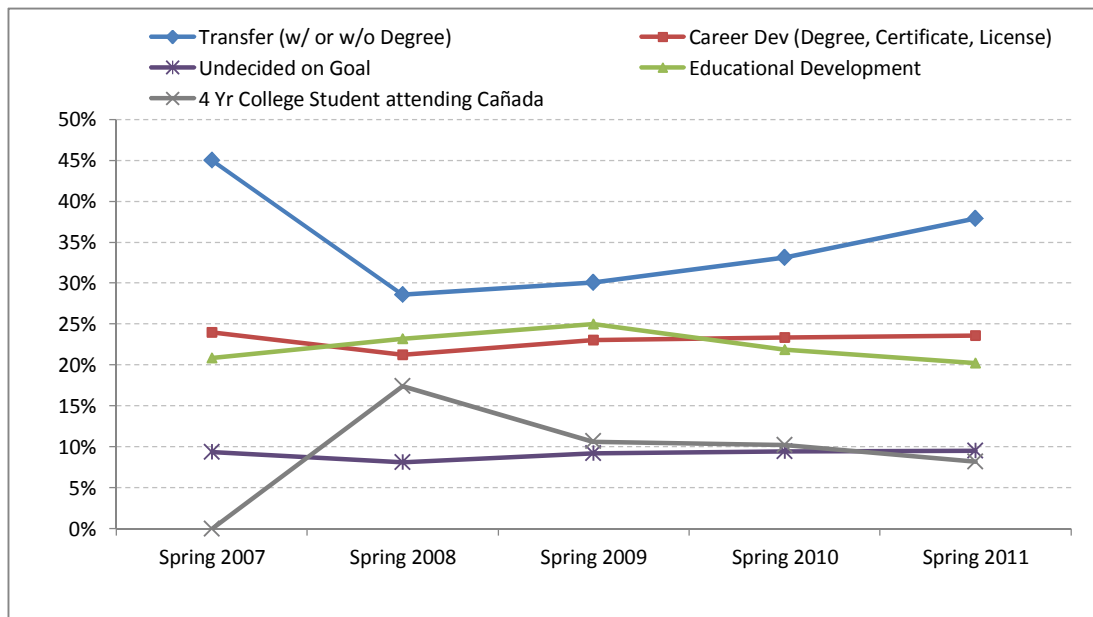
