WHAT IS THE VENDING COMMISSION?

The Vending Commission is a College-based committee funded through vending machine sales. The Vending Commission provides funding for events, activities, and programs that are student focused. In order to qualify for funding through the Vending Commission, a program or activity must benefit or target a maximum number of Cañada students.

All registered clubs and College departments and programs may submit a proposal to the Vending Commission for review. The types of activities and projects potentially funded under this program may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Hospitality programs and related support
- Child care and child development programs
- Athletic programs, intramural sports, and related fitness activities
- Cultural awareness programs promoting mutual respect and appreciation for diversity
- Speakers and lectures on contemporary issues
- Theatrical events
- Recreational programs
- Student center enhancement (e.g., Cafeteria improvements)

Fund Allocation cannot be used for any of the following purposes:

- Scholarships
- Operating or start up costs for a specific club or group
- Attendance at conferences, meetings, retreats or conventions that benefit only the individual club or department
- Payment of membership fees

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Funds will not be automatically transferred into department, club accounts, or program accounts. In order for an account transfer, payment, or reimbursement to occur, invoices and/ or receipts must be received by the Coordinator of Student Activities. Funds must be used during the academic year the grant is awarded.
