Transfer Admission Guarantee at UC campuses

- Seven of the nine UC campuses offer TAG; Students may apply for TAG to one campus only.
- The TAG application is available on *July 1, 2011*, and you may submit it during the TAG application period, *September 1-30, 2011*. You may create an account and apply for TAG by going to [TAG Form Online](#) at <https://uctag.universityofcalifornia.edu/index.cfm>. **Apply on time!**

The following is TAG general criteria for each UC campus. For detail information, please see their WEB page provided below, and meet with a counselor to discuss your eligibility.

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 80 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- Both English course must be completed by the end of Spring 2012
- Math course must be completed by the end of Spring 2012

Minimum GPA requirements:

- **College of Agricultural and Environmental Science = 3.2**

The following Selective majors under this college require additional GPA requirements:

- **Biotechnology** – A minimum GPA of 2.5 in each of the following course sequences: math, chemistry, and biological sciences. If at the time of TAG only one course of the sequence is completed, that course must be completed with a B.
- **Viticulture and Enology** – A minimum GPA of 3.0 in each of the following course sequences: math, general chemistry, Organic chemistry, physics, and biological sciences. If at the time of TAG only one course of the sequence is completed, that course must be completed with a B.
- **Landscape Architecture, Pre** – needs to submit a portfolio in February. Contact the department at (530) 754-8628 or visit www.la.ucdavis.edu
- **Managerial Economics, pre** - minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 in the following courses: math, Economics, and statistics
- **College of Biological Sciences = 3.2**
A minimum GPA of 2.5 in each of the following course sequences: math, chemistry, and biological sciences. If at the time of TAG only one course of the sequence is completed, that course must be completed with a B.
- **College of Engineering = 3.3**

- **College of Letter and Science = 3.2**
The following Selective majors under this college require additional GPA requirements:
 - **Communication**- minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the following courses: Anthropology, Psychology, Sociology, and statistics
 - **International Relations**- minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the following courses: Economic, Anthropology, Psychology, History, international relations or Political Science, and Sociology or statistics
 - **Psychology**- minimum cumulative GPA of 2.9.0 in the following courses: Psychology, statistic, sociology or cultural Anthropology, and biological sciences

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- Dose not accept TAG from students who has a combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- First English course must be completed by the end of Summer 2011, and the second year of English by the end of Spring 2012 term
- Math course must be completed by the end of Summer 2011

Minimum GPA requirements = 3.0 for all UC transferrable courses by Summer 2011 (this is subject to change)

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 80 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- Both English course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011

- Math course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011

Minimum GPA requirements:

School of Engineering = 3.0 for all majors

School of Natural Sciences = 2.9

School of Social Sciences = 2.8

School of Art and Humanities = 3.0

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 60 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- First English course must be completed by the end of Summer 2011, and the second year of English by the end of Spring 2012 term.
- Math course must be completed by the end of Summer 2011

Minimum GPA requirements = 3.0 for all majors

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 90 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- Both English course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011
- Math course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011

Minimum GPA requirements = 3.5 by the end of fall term and maintained through Spring 2012

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 90 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits, excluding AP/IB credits.
- Both English course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011
- Math course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011

Minimum GPA requirements = 3.2 for all majors by the end of fall term and maintained through Spring 2012

College of Letter and science = Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferrable course work in Fall 2011 and Spring 2012

College of Engineering = Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all UC transferrable course work in Fall 2011, and a minimum GPA of 3.2 in all major preparatory course work by the end of fall 2011, and maintain 3.2 GPA by the end of Spring 2012

Unit requirements:

- Completed 30 semester units at the time of TAG application
- Complete 60 semester units by the end of spring 2012
- No more than 20 semester units of combined community college and baccalaureate institution credits
- First English course must be completed by the end of Fall 2011, and the second year of English by the end of Spring 2012 term.
- Math course must be completed by the end of Spring 2012

Minimum GPA requirements = 3.0 for all majors

TAA Criteria:

1. Be a California resident
2. Completed 30 transferrable units in General education at the time of contract
3. Completed 60 transferrable units by the end of Spring 2012 for Fall 2012
4. Completed golden 4 courses (English, Speech, Critical Thinking, and a transferrable math course)
5. Achieved a minimum GPA of 2.0
6. Apply on-line between October 1 and November 30th
7. To be in good standing
8. If Golden 4 is completed outside of California Community College System, CSU certification is required.

Restrictions

- Do not have a bachelor's degree
- TAA is available for Fall term only
- If student plan to apply to Spring 2012, he/she should not apply for TAA for Fall 2012

TAA Criteria:

1. Achieve a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 (including repeated courses)
2. Completed a minimum of 24 transferrable semester units at the time of TAA application
3. Consult with a counselor at Cañada College or an Advisor at Golden Gate University for equivalency and transferability of courses
4. File an [application](#) with an application fee of \$55

1. Completed a minimum of 24 transferrable semester units
2. Achieve a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
3. Complete the [TAA application](#) form
4. Highly recommended to complete the following courses that meets segments of the General Education requirements at NDNU:
 - English 100
 - History 100 or 101
 - Phil 100 or 240
 - Review [articulation agreements](#) Between Cañada and NDNU for further information

- Two courses of English Composition
- One course of college-level mathematics (Bachelor of Arts) or two of college-level mathematics (Bachelor of Science)
- One course in Biological or Physical Science with a lab

- Two courses of English composition
- Two courses of Calculus
- One year of Accounting
- Macroeconomics
- Microeconomics

- Two course of English composition
- Two courses of Calculus
- One course of general Chemistry

Additional requirements:

1. Courses for particular majors:

Biology Major:

- One course of general Chemistry;
- One course of Physiology

Chemistry Major:

- One course of general Chemistry

Physics Major:

- One course in calculus-based Physics

Mathematics and Computer Science Majors:

- Two courses in Calculus
- One course in calculus-based Physics.

Economics Major:

- One course in Calculus
- Microeconomics
- Macroeconomics

Note: Santa Clara University offers an Economics degree in the college of Arts & Science and another through the Leavey School of Business. Please clearly specify "Business" or "Arts & Sciences" on the TAA.

2. The minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) requirement in transferable courses for
- a. Arts & Sciences is 3.3
 - b. Engineering transfers is 3.3
 - c. The Leavey School of Business 3.5
3. **Must earn at least 30 transferable semester units** or 45 transferable quarter units, which must include the required courses listed above, by the end of the Winter/Spring term. Courses planned for the summer term will not be considered in the TAA.
4. Students for whom English is not their first language must complete the SAT I (Scholastic Assessment Test) and TOEFL (Test of English a Foreign Language). The minimum required score on the TOEFL is 213 (computer based). A minimum score of 530 is required on the verbal section of the SAT I and the composite SAT score must be 1100. Students who have completed the English composition and Math requirements, and have achieved at least B grades, are exempted from submitting SAT I. Students who have completed the English Composition requirement, and have achieved at least B grades, are exempted from submitting a TOEFL score.
5. **Forms:** All TAA applicants to submit an admission application via Common Application (www.commonapp.org) in conjunction with the [TAA application](#). Students must specify in their applications that they are submitting a TAA in the "Additional Information" box found in the Common App.
- Santa Clara University will be admitting students on a rolling basis from January 7th through April 15th. **It is strongly recommended to apply early.** Students must submit the following to complete their application:
- Official copy of **all their high school (new requirement) and college** transcripts
 - SAT/ACT scores if they have less than 30 semester/45 quarter units
 - 1 instructor/counselor letter of recommendation
 - \$55 application fee
- Students are not required to submit the following forms:
- College Official's Form
 - Mid-Term Report (upon request only)
 - Secondary School Report

Restrictions

1. The following students are not eligible for TAAs:
- Students who have completed post-secondary coursework outside of the United States
 - Students on academic probation who have been disqualified from another college or university
 - Students who have completed a Bachelor's degree
2. Santa Clara University **does not award academic credit for course taken on a "Pass/No Pass" or "Credit" basis.**

3. Students may only have one of the core courses in-progress when file for TAA, and the rest of the core courses must have been completed by the end of fall preceding TAA application.

Tips:

- Psychology majors must complete Statistics at Santa Clara University
- Social Science students need one transferrable math course (see the link to the College of Art and Sciences)
- Liberal Studies (pre-Teaching) requires Statistics for the major as noted in the transfer guide.

Deadline:

The TAA application period is between January 1st and March 31st.
