How to Apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must apply online at www2.calstate.edu/apply • You complete one application and choose campus and major for each campus. Your application will be sent separately to each campus. • You need to report all, courses completed, in progress, planned and planned for each campus you attended. • It is important to provide an accurate EMAIL ADDRESS. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply online to UC campuses at Website: http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/index.html or apply.universityofcalifornia.edu. • Only one application is necessary to apply to multiple UC campuses!! • The UC campuses will communicate via email; therefore, it is important to have an EMAIL ADDRESS and check it on a regular basis once you submit the application. • In your application, you must provide a list of <u>all</u> courses, your accomplishments, and respond to 4 Personal Insight Questions- each maximum of 350 words.
When to Apply	<p>Winter Quarter 2023: <u>June 1 – 30, 2022</u></p> <p>Spring Semester or Quarter 2023: <u>August 1 – 30, 2022</u></p> <p>Fall Semester or Quarter 2023: <u>October 1 – November 30, 2022</u></p>	<p>UC campuses are on quarter system except UC Berkeley and UC Merced.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Fall 2023: <u>October 1 – November 30, 2022</u> <u>UC Application will be available on August 1, 2022</u></p> <p>UC Irvine, UC Riverside, UC Santa Cruz accept application for Winter 2023 for selected majors. All UC campuses are closed for Spring 2023, except UC Merced. The application deadline for Spring and Winter 2023 is <u>July 1-31st 2022</u></p>
Application Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The application fee is \$70 per campus. • You must include the payment of fees when you submit your application online; otherwise it will not be processed. (You may pay by PayPal, or Credit Card or Debit Card.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The application fee for resident students is \$70 and for non-resident students \$80 per campus. You must include the payment of fees with your application; otherwise it will not be processed. (You may pay by Check, Money Order, or Credit Card.)
	<p>Fee Waivers: The application fees may be waived <i>up to 4 campuses for CSU and 4 campuses for UC</i> for those students who meet the criteria. Students must complete the CSU/UC application to find whether they are qualified.</p>	
Acknowledgement	<p>You will receive acknowledgment from the individual campuses to which you applied. Read this notification carefully and follow the instructions explaining how to check your application status online. Each campus will provide you with a username and password to access your portal page to check your application status and any action you need to take under the “To Do List”.</p>	<p>Once you submit your application, you will receive email from each UC campus to create a username and password for access to your portal page.</p> <p>For more information go to: https://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/how-to-apply/applying-as-a-freshman/after-you-apply/admissions-decisions.html.</p>
Application Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must update your application with the final grades using Cal State Apply. Some of the CSU campuses require a supplemental application and some may ask for an official transcript to reflect your final grades. • You must accept the admission offer, by completing Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by May 1st for fall term. This deadline varies for spring admissions. • Once you create a portal page for each CSU Campus, you must check it constantly to learn about the actions you need to take listed under “To Do List”. • If it is required, arrange to take the English/writing Test as soon as possible. (Some campuses may have waived this requirements due to pandemic.) • The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with spring grades, test scores, and any other documentation is July 15th for fall admission</u>. This deadline for Spring term varies. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will be required to update your application (Transfer Academic Update, TAU) by entering your final grades and confirming your planned courses. The deadline to complete TAU for fall admissions is January 1st-31st, and for winter/spring term is September 15th. • They will notify you of their decision between Mid-March and the end of April • You may accept their admission offer by completing Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) online by June 1st for fall admission. You can accept only one campus and pay a non-refundable fee of \$250. • The deadlines for submitting <u>final transcripts with spring grades, test scores, and any other documentation is July 1st</u>.
	<p>Not updating your application and/or responding to their requests will cause your admission to be rescinded.</p>

You **MUST** submit your final transcript and the certification by the deadline prior to your enrollment.
