In addition to the TAG application students must complete an online admission application between November 1 and November 30, 2020 for fall Admission.

General Information and Eligibility Requirements

What is UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)?

It is a contract between students and University of California (UC) that is offered to eligible students who are seeking guaranteed admission to universities.

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) will guarantee admission to students who meets the TAG criteria for the UC TAG campus and for the major.

How many contracts may be signed at one time?

You may file TAG application to only one UC Campus. However, you may file admission application to several UC Campuses.

What are the general eligibility requirements for UC TAG?

- Have successfully completed 30 transferable units
- Complete preparatory of courses related to your major
- Have met the GPA requirement of the university of choice
- Completed 60 transferable units by the end of preceding transfer semester
For example: If transferring in fall 2022, all required courses must have been completed by the end of Spring 2022.
- Some of the UC campuses are required students to be a full-time student at a community college.
- Some UC campuses are required students to complete transfer level math and English by the end of summer or during fall term before completing the TAG. (See the chart on previous page or visit TAG page of each campus.)

TAG may not apply to all programs

How do I know what courses are required for my major and what is transferrable?

Please meet with your academic counselor to discuss the course path and to develop a Student Educational Plan by:

- Identifying the courses needed for your major
- Exploring how to apply the results of AP exams (if any)
- Exploring TAG and its requirements to strategize your TAG option

Please bring a copy of your transcripts from all colleges attended and the results of AP exams, (if there is any) to your counseling appointment.

For transferability of courses to CSU and UC campuses go to www.assist.org. You may visit the website of the private universities to find the transferability of courses under the “articulation agreements”.

What is my Transfer GPA? Total Transfer points/Total completed Transfer units = Transfer GPA

Please see your counselor or meet with the Transfer program Supervisor/Counselor. GPA calculator is available at the Transfer Center WEB page.

Instructions:

1. Attend TAG Workshop
2. Meet with Transfer counselor to discuss your major and your eligibility, including course transferability, and transfer GPA.
3. Plan courses for fall and Spring term
4. Create an account in Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) to file a UC TAG application
5. Complete a TAG form.
6. Meet with the Transfer Center program supervisor or your counselor to finalize your TAG application before submitting it in September (1-30)
