- Completion of 60 transferable semester units (includes all lower division general education requirements)
- GPA of 2.0
- Completion of required transfer courses (with a grade of "C" or better) :
  - Written Communication
  - Oral Communication
  - Critical Thinking
  - Math or Statistics
