



Common Course Numbering Updates

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Remember

- Legislative effort to improving credit mobility, transferability, and articulation within California's higher education system (AB 1111)
- Creates a student-facing system that ensures course equivalencies across institutions
- ASCCC developed templates for Phase I and II which are built on existing C-ID descriptors when available

Currently

- Phase I was completed and has been implemented since Fall 2025 – 7 courses
- Phase II was completed and has been implemented starting Fall 2026 – 16 courses
- Phase III implementation is currently paused and will follow a later timeline and is anticipated no earlier than Fall 2028 – 52 templates for 44 courses

What's next – Phase III and beyond



- Phase III currently on hold. Goal is still to implement by Fall 2028.
- ~ 44 courses including lab science courses (e.g., Anatomy, Physiology, Chem, etc.)
- Phase III templates underwent an informal, non-binding review by the CSU and UC system offices to evaluate alignment with Cal-GETC and UC transferability requirements.
- AB 2236 (Berman):
 - Requires public and transparent rationale for all CCN template denials including UC transferability, Cal-GETC.
 - Pushes for CCN system-level articulation for UC transferability and Cal-GETC. Goal is that templates will automatically meet UC transferability and Cal-GETC.
