 - a. CCCCO ZTC Grant Updates
 - i. DAA grant: Prof. Emanuela Quaglia completed her MART 362 OER! The remaining element is to set up a way that students in the online sections of MART 379 can purchase the low-cost software that they need for the course.
 - ii. ECE/ENGL grant: Prof. Anna Mills is 95% finished with her digital literacy OER piece; she has the text ready, but needs a bit more time for the Canvas module and ADAPT assignments. Nearing completion.
 - iii. MATH grant: Prof. Amira Alkeswani and Prof. Michael Hoffman have been collaborating on MATH 270, 275 and 251/252 materials. Prof. Ray Lapuz has been working on MATH 253 materials. Good progress, but more news later.
 - b. Updates from CCCCO
 - i. As the funding is winding down, Sarah will be submitting a number of reports over the next year.
 - ii. Materials will start to be updated in Cool4Ed starting October.
 - Updates from the OERI
 - i. Many webinars coming—check out the OERI Webinars page and attend a few.
 - ii. Carlos attended one on the use of Al-based tools; we'll bring this back to campus in a series of workshops. He sees that some of these tools would greatly benefit certain disciplines and departments, including ESL.
