Cañada College is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, an institutional accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation and the U.S. Department of Education.

On January 16, 2024, [the Commission officially notified the College](#) that it has made appropriate progress on implementing its plans and improving outcomes related to student achievement based on its [2023 Midterm Report](#) and related evidence.

On January 27, 2020, [the Commission officially notified the College](#) that, upon consideration of the the College's [Institutional Self-Evaluation](#) as well as the recommendations made by the October, 2019 peer review visiting team, the Commission acted to Reaffirm the College's Accreditation for a period of seven years. The College received two commendations and no recommendations for compliance with the standards.
