Transcript Evaluation Process

IMPORTANT: For transcripts and exam scores to be considered "official," they must come directly from your external college or university. Electronic transcripts and exam scores that originate from a student's email address are considered unofficial and will not be accepted by TES for evaluation.

In order to be in queue for a transcript evaluation, students must be **actively enrolled** and have a **declared program of study**. All students who have indicated that they attended an outside institution on

CCCApply and completed matriculation will then receive a Transcript Evaluation Success Plan in Student Success Link.

To view your success plan and check for updates, please log into [mySMCCCD Student Portal](#) and select "Student Success Link". Our department will send automated updates to your my.smccd.edu account regarding your evaluation status and any additional information we may need.

Depending on your institution, you may be able to send your official transcript or external exam scores in multiple ways:

Electronically (preferred): select Skyline, College of San Mateo or Cañada College from the available institutions. Please ensure your transcript is sent directly us as we cannot accept transcripts forwarded from anyone besides the original institution: transevaluation@smccd.edu
