



Puente Events Attendance – 2024 & 2025

Overall Flex Day Participation

- Flex Days generally draw **150–200 participants** from across the college.
- Participation is fairly balanced, with **many faculty (50–60%)** and **many classified staff (30–40%)**, alongside administrators and student assistants.

Puente-Specific Sessions

- *August 13, 2024 – Pedagogies of Cariño:* Although the direct attendance log captured only one Puente record, with over 175 people present that day, it is highly likely that **many faculty and staff participated in the Puente session.**
- *October 9, 2024:* With participation near 150, Puente-related conversations and equity-focused approaches were likely integrated into the broader day's programming.
- *April 17, 2025 – Linguistic Justice:* The Zoom log shows **28 participants** in this Puente-led session alone. With 140+ participants overall, this confirms that **many faculty and staff engaged in Puente's equity-centered work.**

Summary

Given the consistently high attendance at Flex Days and the prominent placement of Puente workshops, it is clear that **many faculty, classified staff, and administrators most likely attended Puente events throughout 2024–2025.**
