




Enrollment by Instructional Modality from 2019 – 2025



While the COVID-19 pandemic affected the modalities by which Cañada College offered instructions during the period most affected by the statewide lockdown (2020-2022), the balance of program and course offerings across modality has largely recovered to pre-pandemic levels 2024-25.



Total college enrollments have recovered and exceeded pre-pandemic levels by 2023-24 and have continued to grow. The percentage of enrollment in online, asynchronous sections has remained remarkably stable. The College is seeing more students opt for hybrid sections rather than face-to-face sections, to the degree to which there has been a drop in face-to-face enrollments since 2019-20.

Note: at the start of the pandemic (2020-21) the California Community College Chancellor's Office advised all colleges to leave their modality coding of sections as they were when the courses were scheduled prior to the pandemic. So it was not until the spring of 2022 that modality coding became more accurate again.
