Ensure that aligned student support services (e.g., academic supports, food services, etc.) are also available in the evening, if classes are offered in person then. The Good News...

Of an enrolled, Spring 2024 Cohort of AD-T-seeking (non-first-time) students:


- 74% had completed their first Transfer-level English course
- 61% had completed their first Transfer-level Math course

...by the end of Spring 2024

English

- Embedded tutors in English 105 now offer earlier, more integrated student support, with increased collaboration among faculty, writing center coordinators, and support services.
- Faculty alignment in discussing best practices around assessment, assignments, and classroom teaching to address the diverse needs in the classroom and prioritize ant-racist and equity-based teaching.
- Collaborating with student services programs to establish proactive support within English classrooms.

Math



Course Offerings & Curriculum Adjustments:
Continuing Math 251 and 851, offering limited sections of Pre-Calculus (Math 225), and shifting to hard-linked support classes in Fall.



Instructional Support & Collaboration:
Embedding tutors enhance faculty-tutor collaboration through workshops and classroom observations; ongoing placement discussions across the district.



Challenges & Institutional Needs: Addressing high student math anxiety and skill gaps, reducing class sizes for individualized support, and managing heavy grading loads in advanced math courses.

AB 1705 Action Items



Counseling Collaboration: Math department to finalize placement guidelines and communicate updates to counselors.



Continued professional development



Student Support Expansion: Exploring ways to integrate retention services directly into classrooms for both Math and English.

Instructional Support

- Metric 2 – B Increase the embedded and other just-in-time instructional supports for all Math and English sections, not just the co-requisite support courses.
 - Instructional Aides embedded in each section of ENGL 105
 - Three 40% permanent Instructional Aides hired to work in the Writing Center (2024)
 - Writing Center workshops on writing process, and grammar & editing (new)
 - Embedded Tutor support in sections of MATH 200, 241(new), 251, and 252(new)
 - Math JAM workshops for MATH 225 and MATH 251 (Factoring, Compositions & Inputs, Trigonometry, Logs & Exponents)
