

Athletes and the Community of Learning Through Sports (COLTS)

An evaluation prepared by the Office of Planning, Research & Institutional Effectiveness
September 22, 2024

Purpose: To understand whether athletes are more successful than the average college-student? Are the first-year athletes who take the COLTS classes (there are designated sections) more successful? Who are our athletes?

Definition of student groups for the analysis:

Athletes. Athletes are defined by anyone who enrolled in either VARS 104, 114, 154, 170 or TEAM 105, 184, 186, 187 in Academic Year 20-21, 21-22, 22-23 and 23-24. This group only includes students who did not enroll in any COLTS courses.

COLTS Athletes. For the same timeframe, any athlete (defined above) taking a COLTs course was included.

Non-Athlete. All students enrolled at Cañada in the same timeframe who are not Athletes or COLTS Athletes and enrolled in 9+ units in at least one major term in an academic year.

General Observations:

- Athletes and COLTS tend to have higher success and retention rates compared to the non-athlete group. Athletes and Athletes in COLTS generally have larger percentage of students enrolled as full-time. Athletes and COLTS tend to take more units in a major term and have a higher average GPA.
- Athletes and Athletes in COLTS have larger percentage of male students, but a similar race ethnicity breakdown though noticeably fewer Asian students than non-Athletes. Athletes have a larger Black, non-Hispanic population than COLTS or the non-athlete population. Both Athletes and COLTS have a slightly lower Hispanic/Latino proportion and a slightly higher White, non-Hispanic population. These trends are quite stable over time.
- COLTS athletes generally have the larger proportion of first time students than athletes, but fewer than the non-athletes.
