District Antiracism Council

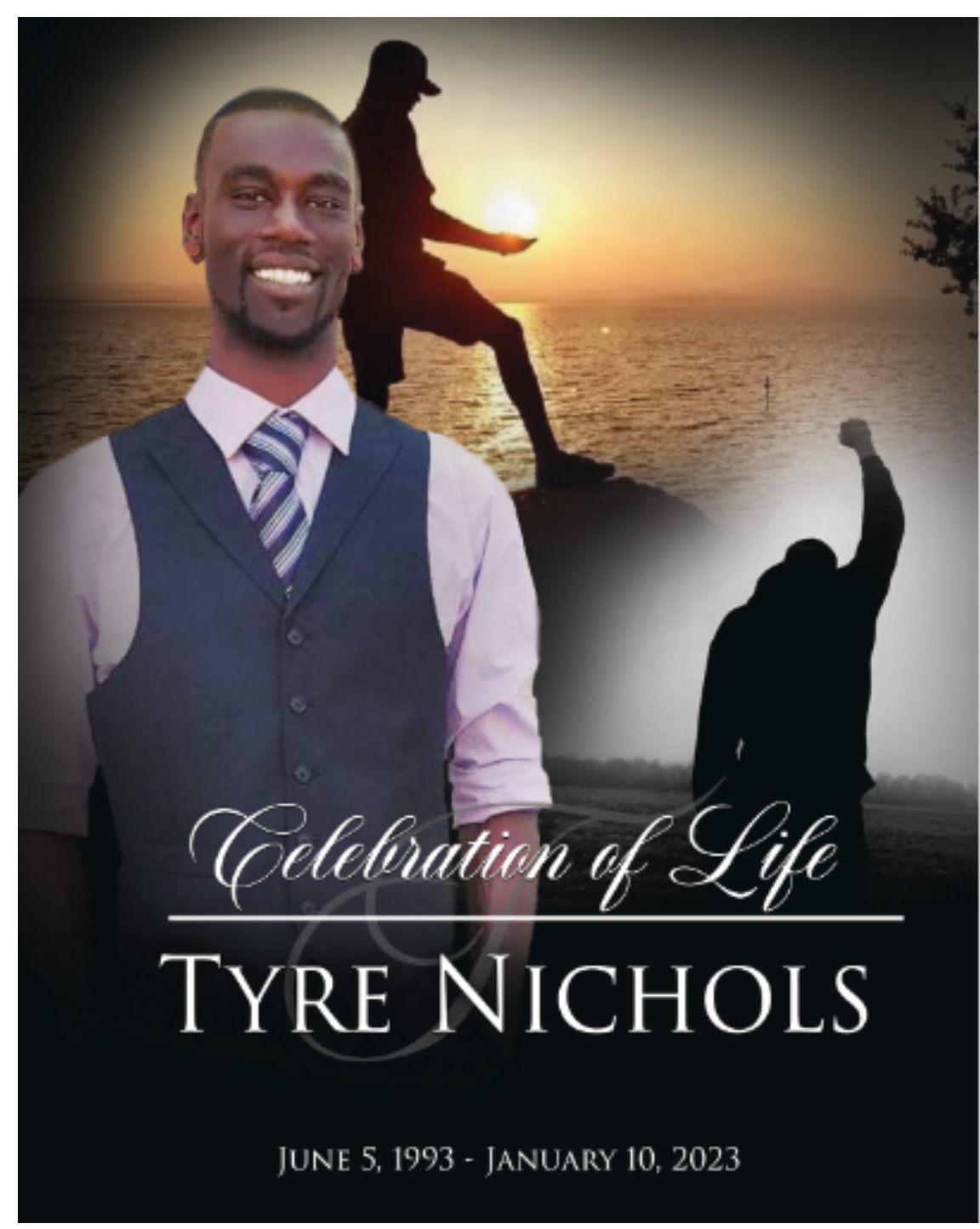
Introduction
