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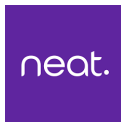
Instructional Technology Tools

Classroom Technology

Below is a list of equipment or spaces that you may find in specific classrooms on campus.

Neatboard



A Neat Board is an interactive whiteboard designed for classrooms and remote learning. It features a touchscreen for writing and collaboration, integrates with video conferencing tools like Zoom, and allows real-time content sharing and cloud storage. Zoom

Calendly

Calendly is a scheduling tool that simplifies appointment booking for educators by allowing students and colleagues to self-schedule meetings based on availability. Pronto

Pronto is a communication tool integrated into Canvas that enables real-time messaging, video calls, and group chats for students, instructors, and staff. It enhances collaboration by allowing easy interaction, file sharing, and notifications within the Canvas platform. Pronto provides real-time language translation for all communications sent through the app.

Canvas Announcements

Canvas Announcements allow instructors to share updates, reminders, and important information with students through their Canvas course. Posts appear in the course's announcement section, and students receive notifications to their SMCCD emails. Instructors can schedule posts and enable replies if desired.

Proctorio

Proctorio is an online exam proctoring software that helps ensure academic integrity during remote assessments. It uses AI and machine learning to monitor students during exams through video, audio, and screen recording. Proctorio can detect suspicious behavior, such as cheating or using unauthorized materials, and alert instructors in real time.

Perusall

Perusall is an interactive platform that lets students collaboratively annotate texts and media, promoting active engagement and discussion. It integrates seamlessly with Canvas, allowing instructors to assign readings, track participation, and facilitate discussions directly within the Canvas environment.

Turnitin



Turnitin is a plagiarism detection tool that checks student submissions for originality by comparing them against a vast database of academic papers, websites, and other sources. It also provides feedback on writing quality. Turnitin integrates with Canvas by allowing instructors to set up assignments that automatically check for plagiarism and generate similarity reports, all within the Canvas platform.

Labster is a virtual lab platform that offers interactive science simulations, allowing students to conduct experiments in a virtual environment. It covers subjects like biology, chemistry, physics, and more, providing a hands-on learning experience without the need for physical labs. Labster integrates with Canvas, enabling instructors to assign simulations, track student progress, and incorporate them into course materials.
