

Mirror or Extend Displays



USB-C


Most common cable.

If your laptop does not have a USB-C port, try a different connection option or use an adapter.

2. Choose to Mirror or Extend Display





MIRRORING DISPLAYS ON MAC


1. Connect Cable

AirMedia


Wirelessly connect to classroom projectors with AirMedia.

AirMedia must be downloaded on your computer or mobile device to use this projection option.

USING ZOOM IN THE CLASSROOM

TIPS

STEP 1	LAUNCH/START THE ZOOM MEETING FROM YOUR LAPTOP	YOU CAN LAUNCH FROM ZOOM, CANVAS, OR A LINK
STEP 2	INSTRUCT STUDENTS TO JOIN THE ZOOM MEETING	ENSURE STUDENTS JOINING IN THE CLASS HAVE THEIR MIC & SPEAKER MUTED
STEP 3	CONNECT LAPTOP/DEVICE TO PROJECTOR	USE THE USB-C CABLE OR OTHER CONNECTION OPTION
STEP 4	SHARE SCREEN OR ADD ZOOM ROOM


Join the Zoom Room to your Zoom meeting, then Share Screen.
