To Whom It May Concern at the CA Community College Chancellors Office,

This letter is to confirm Bay Area Community College Consortium (BACCC) endorsement on Thursday, December 15, 2016, of a **REGION WIDE, Business Information Worker I & II, Certificate of Achievement**. This was approved with the understanding that any college in the region could offer the BIW I & II Certificates without individually requesting regional endorsement. This because even if all 28 colleges in the Bay Region offered the certificate, there would still be a gap in labor market supply.

BACCC handles program endorsements on-line, only bringing program endorsements to meetings/calls if any Dean votes not to endorse, thereby requesting discussion.

All CTE Dean's who voted on this region-wide request, voted to endorse, hence you will not find minutes on the December 15th agenda related to this endorsement other than a note that the Program Endorsement Consent Agenda was approved.

Roughly 48 participants joined the December 15th call, representing 15 colleges.
