 - Each certificate and degree pathway within our division will require an individual entry
 - Each entry includes up to 15 tabs of criteria such as:
 - Accreditations
 - Program fees
 - Occupational outlook
 - Success and retention rates
 - Business partnerships

		 Next steps: We are starting with one degree pathway and waiting for clearance before proceeding. Pulling data from ACCJC (Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges), PRIE (Office of Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness) and O*NET OnLine (Occupational Database sponsored by the U.S. Department of Labor) Then we will be reaching out to full time faculty and PSCs for additional information to complete entries. Submitting incomplete or incorrect information can result in a six-month wait to resubmit which will delay eligibility for WIOA funding.
