- 9) Discussion: Infrastructure, Wifi, working with ITS, inventory equipment, new technology, ADA compliance, evaluating ADA compliance, expanding DRC.
- 10) Budget 2014-2015
  - a. Establish a cost-effective criteria for replacement of computer and ITS equipment.
