- Classes held only on Thursday evening and two Saturdays per month.
- Students will receive priority enrollment in all College for Working Adult classes. CWA classes are guaranteed...

- Students will follow a predetermined set of classes, eliminating guesswork about degree and transfer requirements.
- Now CWA students will earn one or all of the following four degrees:
 - 1. AA-T Psychology
 - 2. AA Interdisciplinary Studies: Social and Behavioral Sciences
 - 3. AA Interdisciplinary Studies: Arts & Humanities
 - 4. AA Economics (for those seeking a 4-year degree in Business)
- The 60+ credits earned in this program fulfill all general education and transfer requirements for most public and private colleges and universities.
- Students join a "learning community". They will start and complete the program with the same group of students. This provides students a deeper understanding of the courses' subject matter while they build relationships and learn together inside and outside of the classroom.
- Students receive one-on-one academic advising/counseling from our designated CWA counselor to ensure they get started on the right track and stay on track throughout the program.
