- Classes held on Thursday evening and two Saturdays per month. Online classes also available.
- Students will receive priority enrollment in all College for Working Adult classes.

- Students follow a predetermined set of classes, eliminating guesswork about degree and transfer requirements.
- Now CWA students can earn one or more of the following four degrees:
 - 1. AA-T Psychology
 - 2. AA-T Sociology
 - AA-T Social Work and Human Services
 - 4. AA Interdisciplinary Studies: Social and Behavioral Sciences
 - AA Interdisciplinary Studies: Arts & Humanities
 - AA Economics (for those seeking a 4-year degree in Business)
- The 60+ credits earned in this program fulfill all general education and transfer requirements for most public or private colleges and universities.
- Students join a "learning community". They will start and complete the program with other CWA students. This provides students an opportunity to build relationships and learn together inside and outside of the classroom.
- Students receive one-on-one academic advising/counseling from our designated CWA counselor to ensure they get started on the right track and stay on track throughout the program.
- Students receive one-on-one specialized tutoring from our own CWA Instructional Aides who are familiar with our CWA curriculum.
