

What is a course material?

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Course Materials

Yes, these are 'course materials'*!

- Textbooks
- Lab manuals
- Homework platforms/sites
- Streaming videos
- Library-based resources
- Applications that students use to do their work

No, these are not 'course materials'*.

- Lab kits
- Art supplies
- Calculators
- Yoga mats

Important Information

- Colleges are to develop new or existing ADT/Certificate of Achievement zerocost programs
 - Focus on high-value programs AND/OR meets an emerging regional business industry need AND/OR those with high textbook costs
- These funds can be used for professional development and technical assistance
- Pathways and hiring are determined locally
- Everything must be able to be institutionalized after the funding has run out
- Academic Senate is to be consulted with respect to implementation of the Pathways

Other Important Information

- Pathways must include:
 - Core courses
 - Selectives
 - GEs
- Need to offer as many sections as possible for each course as ZTC
- Materials adopted, remixed or authored must be accessible and customizable (CC-BY, CC-BY-NC)
- ADT/Certificate Pathways should be implemented within 3 academic years of receiving funding, if not sooner.

Phase 1: \$20,000 (in our coffers now!)

- Spring 2023 cohort of ZTC Adopter Program
 - \$500 for training
 - \$750 for adoption; \$2,000 for remix
 - Focus on GE courses not already converted
- Funding for Library resources (e.g. eBooks, subscriptions)
- OER/ZTC Training for Student Tech Assistants, Embedded Tutors and Peer Mentors—On-going
- Fall 2022 ZTC/LTC Student Survey--Launched
 - What's working well?
 - What are the needs/challenges?

Phase 3: \$180,000 (coming in 2023)

- Expanding to as many ZTC Pathways (both ADTs and Certificates) as possible
 - Likely candidates include ANTH, COMM, ECE, PHYS, MATH (they're the most ready right now)
 - Want to engage all departments in this work
 - Funds to expand ZTC Adoption Program to fall, spring and summer
- Addressing the student needs (data from student engagement work in Phase 1)
- Further funding for more Library resources (e.g. eBooks, subscriptions)
- Further training for faculty and students, including improving Canvas-based training
- ZTC Coaches (to allow for more projects to be funded throughout this process)
- Potentially a PSC to help with data and analysis
- Opportunity for faculty to author, not just remix/adopt






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
Do you find the course materials useful?




Do you find the course materials easy to use?




What devices do you use to access your course materials?




Do you feel comfortable using the course materials?

- How can we spread out our ZTC courses across time/day and modality?





MATHEMATICAL CONCEPTS AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING (3 units)	Can be done (3 ZTC), but could use more growth
ARTS AND HUMANITIES (9 units)	Good (9 ZTC), but need to work on more representation across disciplines
SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (9 units)	Strong (14 ZTC, 6 LTC), but could use more representation across disciplines
PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES (7 units)	Strong (12 ZTC), but could be stronger
LOTE (1 course or equivalency)	Only 3 course are ZTC; area of growth

	ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMMUNICATION AND CRITICAL THINKING (9 units)	Improving in COMM, but could use more ENGL, PHIL
	SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING (9 units)	Strong (15 ZTC), but could use more growth
	ARTS AND HUMANITIES (9 units)	Good (14 ZTC, 4 LTC), but need to work on more representation across disciplines
	SOCIAL SCIENCES (6 units)	Strong (17 ZTC, 4 LTC), but could use more representation across disciplines
	LIFELONG LEARNING AND SELF DEVLEOPMENT (3 units)	Adding more DANC/FITN courses, but not many courses available
	ETHNIC STUDIES (3 units)	All ZTC!
