



What are Honors Classes and why should you take them?

Honors Classes

- For motivated and curious students
- More advanced topics and research
- More critical thinking, extended analysis, creative synthesis
- Not always more work, but *different* work

Dig deeper into something that interests you!





Benefits of Taking Honors Classes

Benefits

- Personal satisfaction of high caliber work
- Develop a close relationship with your professor
- Honors notation on your transcript
- Discuss your research on your transfer application
- Present and/or publish your work



Honors Course Schedule

Take two honors courses or one honors course and one contract per year, ideally one course or 3-4 Honors units each semester.

Honors ENGL 100/105 or MATH 200 recommended for first semester students

Honors Counseling


Let's Make a plan!

- 15 units of Honors coursework needed to complete the HTP.
- Some majors require lower division prep-work by the fall term you apply.
- May want an Honors course in your major completed prior to applying so you can address the experience in your PIQs.

Suggested Honors Course Plan

15 units of Honors coursework are needed to complete the HTP. Below is a suggested course plan if you plan to be at Cañada College for 4 semesters.

First Fall Semester

- ENGL 100 or 105 Honors (3 units) or ENGL 110 Honors (3 units) or MATH 200
- Or start in IDST 150 and do an Honors Contract-IDST 150 required for all honor students, but you can take it any semester

First Spring Semester

- ENGL 110 Honors (3 units) ... or another Honors Course. English 110 is required for all honors transfer program students
- LIB 100 Honors (1 unit) Or IDST 150 and do an Honors Contract
- CRER 110 (1 unit) ... take the spring before you apply for transfer

Second Fall Semester

- Honors Course (3 units) ... or Honors Contract (3 units): ASTRO, COMM, HIST 202, MATH 253, PHIL 240, or SOCI 100
- IDST 150: Honors Research Seminar (1 unit) ... if not taken previously
- You will also complete your <u>TAG</u>, transfer applications and apply for scholarships

Second Spring Semester

- Honors Contract (3 units) ... or another Honors Course
- IDST 150 (1 unit) ... if not taken previously
- You will also complete your UCLA TAP paperwork (if applying to UCLA) and apply for scholarships







Joining and Completing the Honors Transfer Program





Eligibility

- Current enrollment or completion of ENGL 100 or ENGL 105
- Minimum High school GPA of 3.3, or college GPA of 3.3 in at least 9 units of transferable courses

Completion

- English 110 Honors (required if started in or after fall 2024)
 IDST 150 Honor Research Seminar (required if started fall 2025)
 15 Honors Units (max 2 contracts) with C or better & 3.3 transfer GPA
- Academic Integrity
