
UCLA TAP Priority Transfer Program

UCLA Transfer Acceptance Rates

- Nationally/Internationally: <u>9%</u>
- Statewide: 12%
- Cañada non-TAP: 19-21%
- Statewide UCLA TAP certified 70-83%
- Cañada UCLA TAP: 86-100%!
 - o 92% last year!

How to maintain status in the HTP?

Maintaining Status in HTP

- 15 Honors Units (max 2 contracts) with C or better... and 3.3 or higher transfer GPA
- Academic Integrity
- Complete the tasks in the Honors Canvas Shell





It takes planning to complete HTP

- •Required: 2 courses (or a honors contract and course) a year
- •Recommended: 1 Honors course each semester
- •Use our three valuable one-unit Honors courses
 - LIB 100: Intro to Library Research
 - CRER 110: Transfer Essentials (spring before you apply)
 - IDST 150: Honors Research Seminar
- •Consider an Honors Contract in your discipline

What is a Priority Transfer Agreement?

- Priority transfer <u>consideration</u> and/or other benefits for Honors Transfer Program completers:
- Benefits vary by school:
 - priority acceptance **consideration**
 - special scholarships
 - housing priority
 - entrance into college Honors program





Who is eligible for priority transfer agreements?

•Students who finish the Cañada College HTP

- Complete 15 Honors Units with a C or better.
- 3.30 UC-transferable GPA.
- Academic Integrity

AND

- Applying to transfer as a junior-standing (min. 60 UC-transferable units)
- Transfer school participates in the Honors agreement.

- •UCLA TAP certified students get <u>priority admission</u> consideration
- •TAP for majors in College of Letters and Sciences, Public Health, Public Affairs, and Education and Social Transformation. 98 undergraduate majors in The College (previously named Letters & Sciences!

•Colleges not included: School of Arts/Architecture, School of Engineering, School of Music, School of Nursing, and School of Theater/Film/Television.

•TAP certified students can apply for an alternate major

UCLA – TAP Preparation and Applying

- •Research UCLA majors early during your time at Canada.
- •Complete lower division **prep work** for major and alternate major.
- •Meet regularly with a **Counselor** to review your Ed Plan.
- •If possible, complete your lower division prep by Fall.
- •Do not choose one of the 15 restricted majors as your alternate.





UCLA – TAP Process

October-November

- Complete the UC Transfer Application between Oct. 1 Nov. 30.
- Attend Transfer Center workshops for support with application.
- Work with Counselors to make sure your application is accurate.
- You do not need to indicate UCLA-TAP on your application, but mention HTP.

January/Early February

- Update UC application with Fall grades and changes to SP schedule. (by 1/31)
- Complete UCLA Applicant Agreement Form
- Meet with Honors Counselor to verify and sign your UCLA TAP form.





UC- Irvine

UCI - TRANSFER HONORS

- •Submit your UC Application in Oct. Nov.
- Fulfill UC transfer admissions requirements
- Fulfill ALL major-specific requirements
- •UCI considers our program evidence of enhanced rigor
- Have opportunity to apply to their Honors program





- 1. Intent to Transfer Form
- 2. Update Student Educational Plan (SEP)
- 3. Complete lower division required major courses.
- 4. If applying for fall 2026, work on transfer applications and PIQ
- 5. Get feedback on your PIQs
- 6. Update transfer application in January
- 7. Meet with Honors Counselor in January/February








