    - Call/leave message for our CWA counselor as often as you like (24/48 hour turnaround)
  - Counselor assists with all forms preparation and submits to A&R
    - Academic renewal Course substitution
    - Dismissal/reinstatement

- Prerequisite challenge Petition
- Reviews previous transcripts for preliminary transfer credit
- Prepares your comprehensive Education Plan in Degree Works
  - Education Plan is reviewed with our CWA counselor every semester
- Prepares and submits your course registration every semester
- Proactively contacts students who might need assistance with tutoring support \_






\*CWA Student cumulative GPA's as of Fall 2018 term.
