As long as the first option for students is a zero cost textbook it is okay to offer a secondary option for purchase (like print on demand)

#### THE TEXTBOOK IN MY CLASS IS VERY LOW-COST

If your course does not offer a free textbook option to your students then it cannot be considered ZTC, even if the textbook is low-cost

## STUDENTS ACCESS THE TEXTBOOK THROUGH ONE OF THE LIBRARY'S EBOOK DATABASES

The no-cost textbook option does not have to be OER as long as it is free and accessible to students, it is okay if the institution pays for access to the textbook

### THERE IS AN EBOOK VERSION OF MY TEXTBOOK AVAILABLE BUT IT IS NOT FREE FOR STUDENTS

There must be a non-cost textbook option available to students, whatever the format of the textbook.

# THERE IS A PRINT COPY OF MY TEXTBOOK AVAILABLE FOR SEMESTER LENGTH CHECK-OUT FOR ALL THE STUDENTS IN MY COURSE

As long there are enough copies of the material for each course that uses the material to go around for each student your course qualifies as ZTC.
