Discuss Learning

- How do we use what we know about our department towards our learning design? How does our learning design influence the student experience?

 - What's working or not working in the classroom? (e.g., course offerings, at the program-level)
 - What stories are the data telling you?

Assessment as a process

- Consider using assessment to think intentionally about our students' learning and our instructional DESIGN.
- Continue to reflect on our students' learning experiences and to communicate.
 - What experiences, strengths and resources do our students bring to their learning experiences?
 - How well do we connect with folks outside of our departments/areas?
 - What information do we need from other programs/courses/areas to better support student learning success?
- Continue to report assessment results in TracDat (follow 3-year plan)
