• Jenna French, Learning Disability Specialist-- DRC, Wellness Center

Jenna presented on the services provided by DRC. She gave an overview of Learning Disabilities and testing to qualify for services/accommodations.

There has been an increase in the number of students accessing DRC services. Some disabilities are visible (for example, if someone uses a wheelchair) but others are not (such as learning disabilities).

Students have free access to 8 sessions per year of personal counseling. They can also be referred to community resources. Personal counseling is confidential.

Health services: staffed by a registered nurse and a nurse practitioner. Services: first aid, OTC medications, blood pressure, flu shot, etc.
