

### 5 STEPS TO START YOUR FIRST SEMESTER AS A CAÑADA COLLEGE STUDENT

4. ATTEND INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION
5. ATTEND MATH or WORD JAM or WORKSHOPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (OPTIONAL)
