Dear New International Students,

Congratulations again on your acceptance to Cañada College! Now that you have been admitted, the next step is for you to pre-register for classes. You may pre-register for an English as a Second Language (ESL) or English class and a general education class.

You are still required to attend the **3-day International Student Orientation starting Wednesday, January 3, where you may need to change the pre-registered classes depending on the results of your ESL/English placement tests.** The International Student Orientation schedule is available on our website at: <http://canadacollege.edu/international/newstudents.php>.

Steps on how to register are below and you can also view an online orientation video with instructions on how to prepare for your departure and register for classes at the above link.

1. To register for classes, you must determine whether you are in **Group A, B, or C**, based on your English proficiency scores listed on the next page.
2. Log onto WebSmart here: <https://websmart.smccd.edu/>. Your User ID is your student ID# and your Pin is your birthday in this format MMDDYY. Click on "Registration," then "Registration Add/Drop." Input the 5-digit CRN# in the boxes below or do a class search. Descriptions of classes and CRN#s can be found on WebSchedule here: <https://webschedule.smccd.edu/>. Make sure to search **Cañada College** classes only. Find required classes here: <http://canadacollege.edu/degrees/>.
3. Register in either an English as a Second Language (ESL) class or English (ENGL 100) class
4. Register in one general education (GE) class (optional). If you don't register for additional classes now, you will need to register during orientation to be sure that you have a **minimum of 12 units**.
5. Pay for tuition or set up a payment plan. In WebSmart, click on "Student Account" to review your tuition and fees and click on "Pay by credit card" or "Set up a payment plan."
