B. CCSSE survey results

Dean Hsieh presented results of the 2013 ILO assessment, a student survey performed in spring 2013 semester. There were 387 respondents, 79 students self reported that they have completed 45 units of coursework. Three comparisons were used: students who have completed 45 units or more, compare to the national average for medium size college, student with 45 units or less. Conclusion is that students who have completed 45 units or more doesn't perform better than students who have completed 45 units or less.

Results of this survey serve as benchmark to compare to future results.
