In Fall 2013, at the request of faculty, Cañada's Academic Senate agreed to study and create a transparent and equitable process by which faculty can request reassigned time (a.k.a release time). Through collaboration with the Office of Instruction and IPC, we have accomplished our goal. The resulting process is now being implemented for all current and proposed discretionary reassigned time for Fall 2015.

Applications to renew current reassignments and to consider new proposals are due to Jo'an Tanaka in the Office of Instruction (tanakaj@smccd.edu) no later than Feb. 17, 2015.
