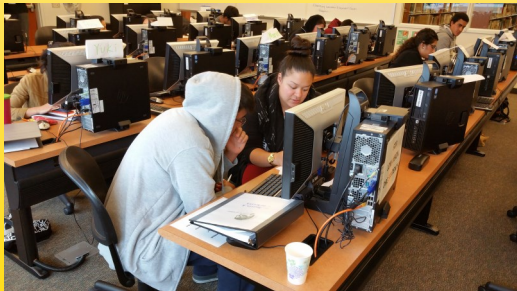

The Learning Center Tutors work to provide comprehensive tutoring support for all Cañada College students. We seek to provide free, course centered, faculty involved academic support service which provides supplemental instructional support to all currently enrolled students.



How Can A Tutor Help Me?

Tutors can help in a variety of ways and can make the material that seems impossible clear and manageable. Here are some things that tutors can assist you with:

- 1) Clarifying class concepts
- 2) Study Tips/Organization
- 3) Exam review
- 4) Reviewing missed questions from homework and/or exams
- 5) The Writing Process

Tutoring should not be used to do your homework. It is always better to try your homework on your own and do the best that you can with it, even if it is all wrong. A tutoring session will help you clarify the process to getting the correct answer, making the learning experience better for you the student. Tutors cannot help you with online exams. All exams must be taken by the student enrolled in the class.

How Do I Prepare for My Tutoring Session?

Preparation before a tutoring session makes time spent with a tutor more valuable. Here are some tips on how you can be prepared for your next tutoring session:

- 1) **Be sure to bring all your materials.** This includes your textbook, handouts, and any other study materials that are related to the assignment(s) for which you are looking assistance.

- 2) **Attempt the assignment on your own.** As stated before, tutoring sessions are not for completing homework, they are for gaining clarity on the work that you have completed. If you get it wrong the tutor is there to help you correct the mistakes so that you can then make the necessary corrections.

How Do I Get Tutoring Assistance?

Drop In Service*:

- 1) Review the tutor schedules posted or online and come in when a tutor for the subject needed is available.
- 2) Log in for tutoring by entering your G# on the computers near the tutor board with the Orange Band across the top.
- 3) Once logged in, take a flag to your seat in the tutoring area.
- 4) If you **have** a question, **raise the flag on your table.** A tutor will be with you shortly. If you **do not have** a question at the time, you can **leave your flag laying down.**
- 5) Once finished, please return flag.
- 6) Log out of the computer.

*No advanced appointment needed. Please check the posted schedule for tutor and subject availability.

Course success rates increase by 22% points in Humanities and 12% points in Math when students receive 1.5 hours of tutoring per week.
