Send a well-written email to your professor letting them know your interest in applying for an internship. Kindly as if they would be willing to serve as your reference and <a href="mailto:attach your resume">attach your resume</a> to the email so they have background information to speak to in your recommendation. (Tip: inform you recommender ASAP to give them ample time to write a quality letter)
