Men's and Women's Soccer Teams Continue to Have Impressive Pre-seasons

Both men's and women's soccer completed their preseason schedules with great games against some very strong competition. On Tuesday the Lady Colts battled crosstown rivals Foothill College to a 1-1 draw. The Lady Colts will host the City College of San Francisco at 4 p.m. on Friday, October 4. The men continue to build an impressive resume. Their power ranking is currently #7 in the state and 3rd in Northern California. Already this season the Colts have a win over the #2 team in Northern California Santa Rosa (2-1) and a draw against the #8 team in the state, Fullerton (1-1). On Saturday, Cañada erased a 3-1 halftime deficit to defeat a game Feather River team, 4-3. And then on Wednesday, they handed a very good squad from Clovis College their second loss of the

season by a score of 2-1. The next home contest for the men's soccer is at 4 p.m. on Tuesday, October 8 against Foothill College.
