Thank you to everyone who attended our annual Campus Holiday Gathering on Monday! It was wonderful to see you all and to celebrate the end of the semester together during this festive season.




Colts Men's Soccer End Season at State Championship

Cañada College hosted two Super Registration Events on December 2 and 4 from 2–8 p.m., intentionally offering extended evening hours to ensure that working students and families could attend after work - an important equity practice that reduces barriers to enrollment. Across the two events, more than 205 students were served. Super Registration Events are unique in that attendees can complete all of their enrollment steps in a single day, including submitting a college application, completing orientation and placement, meeting with a counselor, registering for Spring 2026 classes, applying for financial aid, obtaining a student ID and more.
