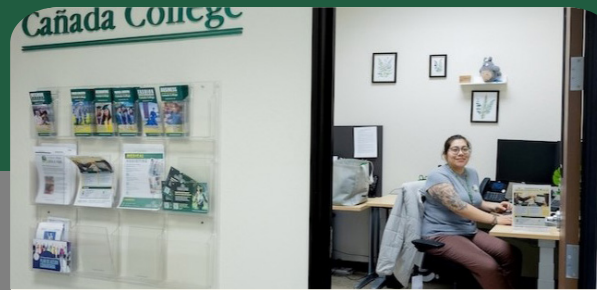




Highlights
