
About Cañada College

CELEBRATING OVER 50 YEARS OF EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

In 1968, our doors opened to the community, providing quality education, competitive degrees, access to classes and technology, and transformative experiences.

Construction of Cañada College was made possible in large part from proceeds from a second bond issue of \$12.8 million approved by District voters in March 1964. Educational and architectural planning for Cañada was accomplished in 1964-66 and proceeded on the theory that a first phase for at least 2,000 students should be designed to permit expansion ultimately to 8,000 day students. The first classes — for 2,000 students — were held in September 1968.

The Cañada College Dedication Program was held on April 27, 1969. The first President, Bill Goss, welcomed dignitaries including Francis Pearson Jr. then President of the Board of Trustees. The total cost to build the campus was \$12.2 million. The 241,000 square feet of buildings cost \$24.77 per square foot to build.

Cañada College provides our community with a learning-centered environment, ensuring that students from diverse backgrounds have the opportunity to achieve their educational goals by providing transfer, career-technical, and basic skills programs, and lifelong learning.

The Promise Scholars Program is a comprehensive student support model proven to dramatically increase graduation rates for students. Promise Scholarships support the program by removing financial barriers for full-time students. It provides first-year scholarships from \$1,200 to \$1,500, free or loaned books, plus personalized counseling. The Promise Scholars Program currently has 336 students in the Fall 2018 cohort.
