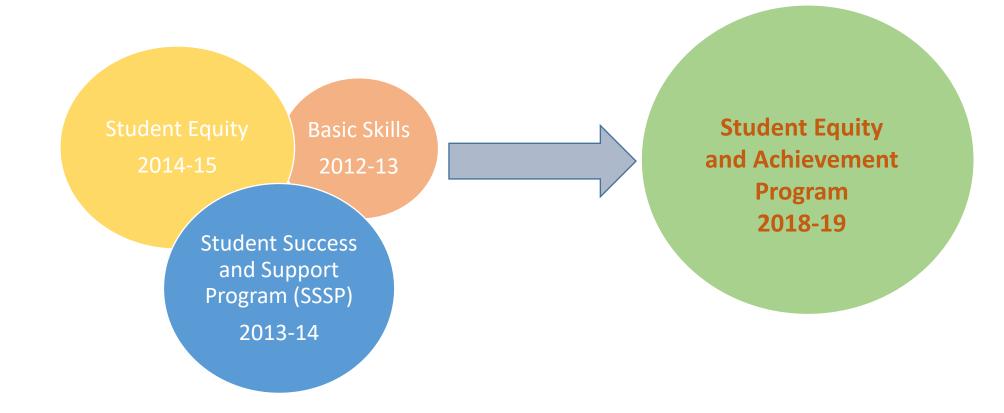

Student Equity and Achievement Program (SEA Program) Evolution





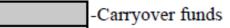
SEA Program Benefits

 - 2. develop the appropriate timeline to transition to other funding source.
