## UCLA 2024 Data and Transfer Alliance Program (TAP) Data

- 9%: UCLA acceptance rate overall
- 21%: Cañada College Non-TAP - non-honors acceptance.
- 83%: UCLA TAP acceptance rate across California Community College Honors Programs
- **86%: Cañada College HONORS TRANSFER PROGRAM STUDENTS!!**

As shown in the chart below, among other benefits, this significantly improves students' chances of transferring to UCLA. Our admittance rate was especially strong in 2024.

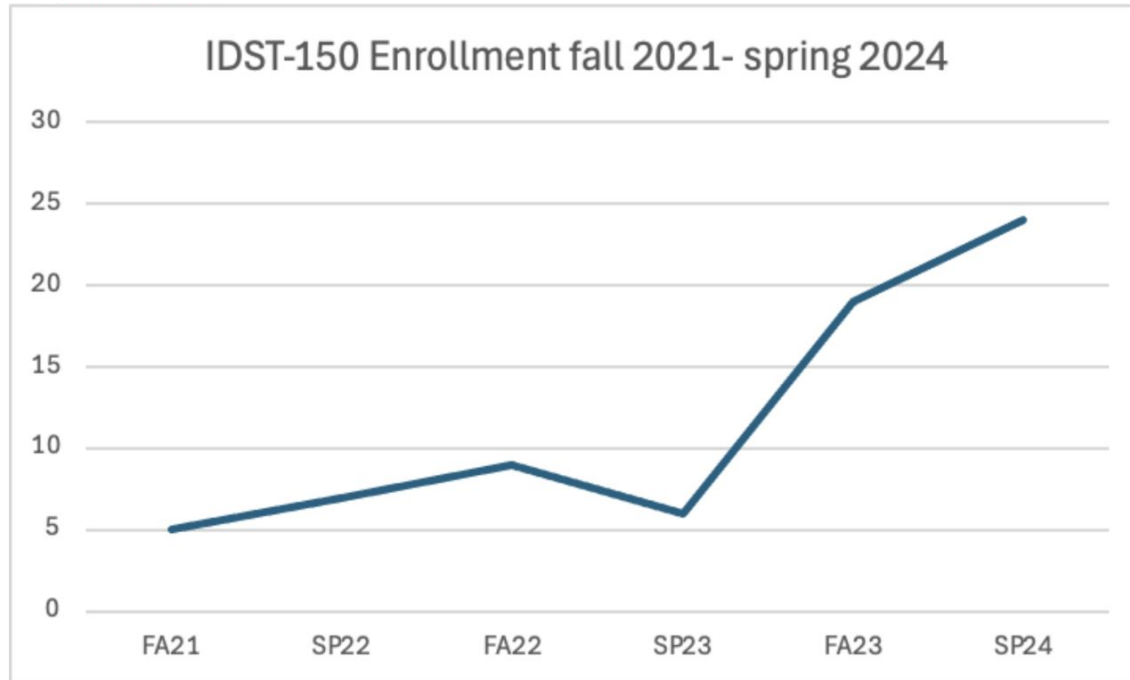

# Honors Counselor Duties: 18-20 hours

1. Participates in Events: Honors Kickoff, Honors Transfer Workshop, Honors Showcase, and often BHC
2. Outreach events like HS registration and recruitment
3. UCLA TAP meetings - at least once a semester
4. UCLA TAP certification
5. Meeting with prospective UCLA TAP students to verify that they are going to complete HTP and the paperwork for UCLA
6. Advising students on choosing an alternative major that is allowable (there is a specific list that often changes and a list of majors that are disallowed) for UCLA TAP
7. UCI Certification -
8. Explaining the UCI honors program honors to honors program and being able to explain the difference and what it means to commit to each.
9. General inquiries about HTP: the benefits, how to complete
10. Rolling Review of Honors Applications and follow up on information only the honors counselor has such as student GPA and honors course progress
11. Required meetings with an Honors Counselor are part of TAP agreement. The Honors counselor helps students figure out if a student wants to take advantage of any of the opportunities through the honors program, help them make sure they are preparing. For example, if student wants UCLA TAP, they need to choose a major in Letters and Science and do the prep courses on time.
12. Helping students to access information and programs that are in the specific Transfer Alliance Partnerships at colleges and universities across the nation
13. Track honors completion-number of units, maintaining GPA, requirement of doing two classes a year
14. Identify students who complete the program and verifying that they have the required number of units and GPA
15. Attend the Recognition and Achievement Ceremony
