Transfer Plan History

- Fall 2020 The Transfer Task force was formed to develop the first ever college transfer plan.
- Fall 2021 The 2021-2024 Transfer Services Plan was adopted by PBC
- Spring 2025 the 2025-2028 Transfer Services Plan was adopted by PBC
- The implementation of the Transfer Services Plan is overseen by the Transfer Advisory Work Group

- The Transfer Advisory Workgroup consists of on-campus and off-campus partners working towards promoting the transfer success of Cañada College students and in implementing the college's Transfer Services Plan

2025-2026 Transfer Services Plan Accomplishments

- (1) Develop clear transfer maps to UC, CSU and privates*
 - *Working on final iteration, should be complete by Spring 2026*
- (3) Require programs to discuss transfer impact in program review with an equity-minded lens (COMPLETE)*
 - *SSPC workgroup updated SSPC program review questions including a specific question about transfer*
- (4) Transfer Advisory Committee (COMPLETE)*
 - *Transfer Advisory Committee formed and meeting the 4th Wednesday of each month*
- (5) Develop transfer communication strategies for faculty and staff to build transfer support capacity reflective of equity-mindedness and antiracism (i.e. newsletter, website, canvas) (COMPLETE)*
 - *CANVAS page set up, regular newsletter going out*
- (8) Leverage district wide transfer partnership (COMPLETE)*
 - *Data-sharing Agreement established with California State University East Bay, San Francisco State University, Notre Dame da Namur, methods of data tracking student*
- (10) Partner with programs/departments to develop events with an equity-minded transfer focus that align with program mission (COMPLETE)*
 - *Campus visits through University visits working group*
- (13) Data (COMPLETE, STILL NEED TO BE IMPLEMENTED)*
 - *Transfer Engagement Survey questions developed*
- (14) Ensure students with a transfer goal are in ADT programs of study when available. (COMPLETE)*
 - *State mandated, districtwide project implemented, regular reports generated and communication to impacted students happens continuously.*
