

Cañada College Overview and Facts: Spring 2016


For nearly 50 years, Cañada College has provided enriching and life-changing educational opportunities for the residents of San Mateo County. Located in the heart of the Silicon Valley, Cañada College offers hundreds of day, evening, and weekend courses in more than 50 quality degree programs, as well as over 40 certificates of achievement. The College has established over 200 articulation and transfer agreements with the University of California (UC), the California State University (CSU), and private universities.


Additionally, it is one of only three federally-designated Hispanic Serving Institutions in the San Francisco Bay Area. A total of 6,318 students enrolled in the college in spring 2016, with 36% of them being male students and 61% being female students. 














Student Geographic Location
