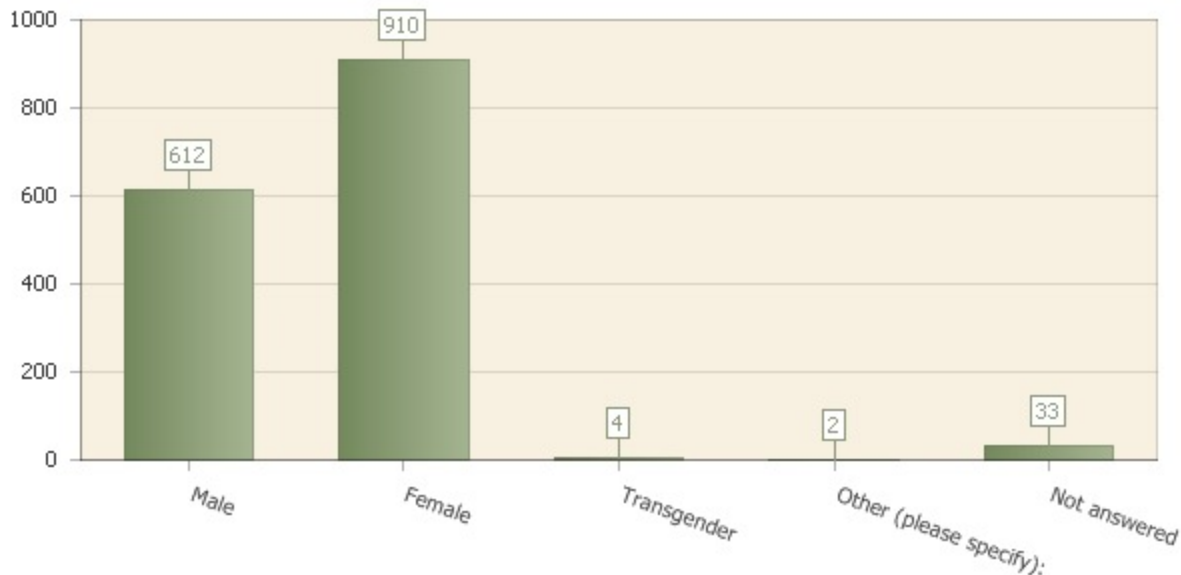

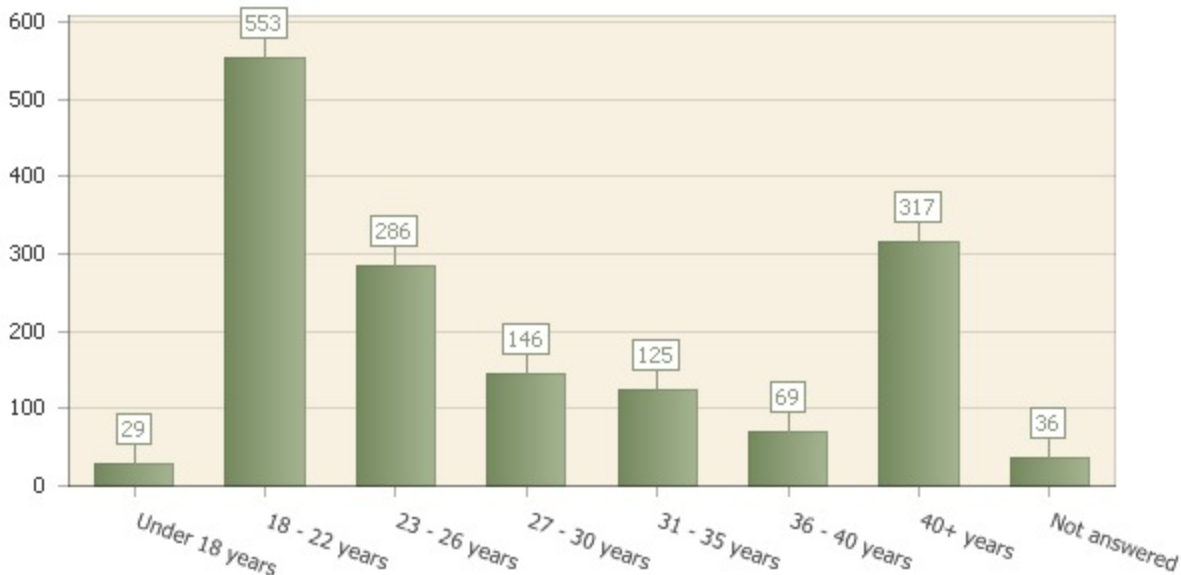

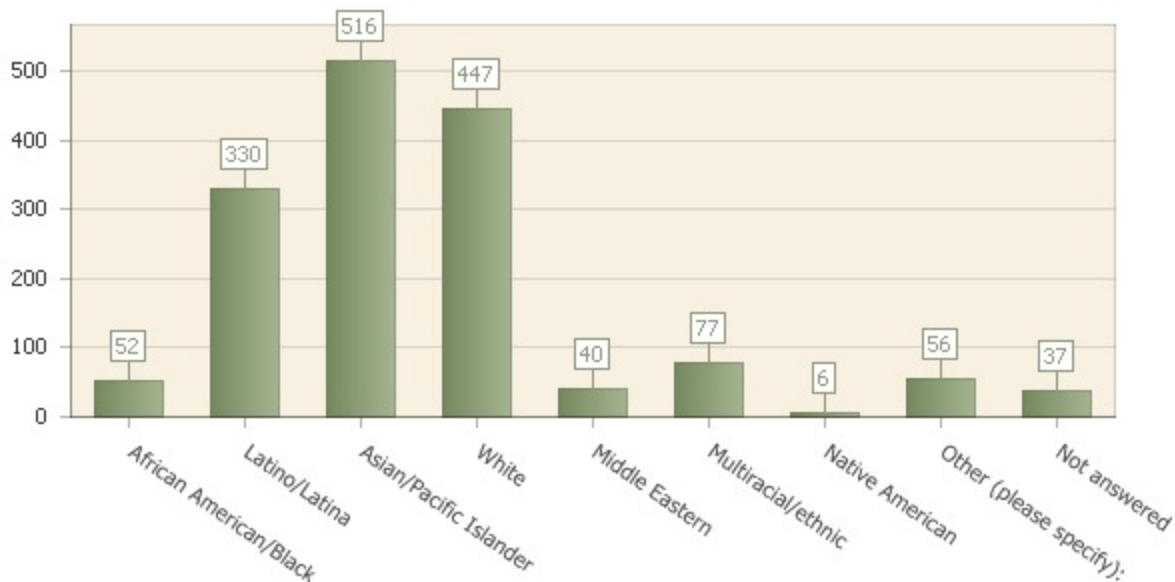

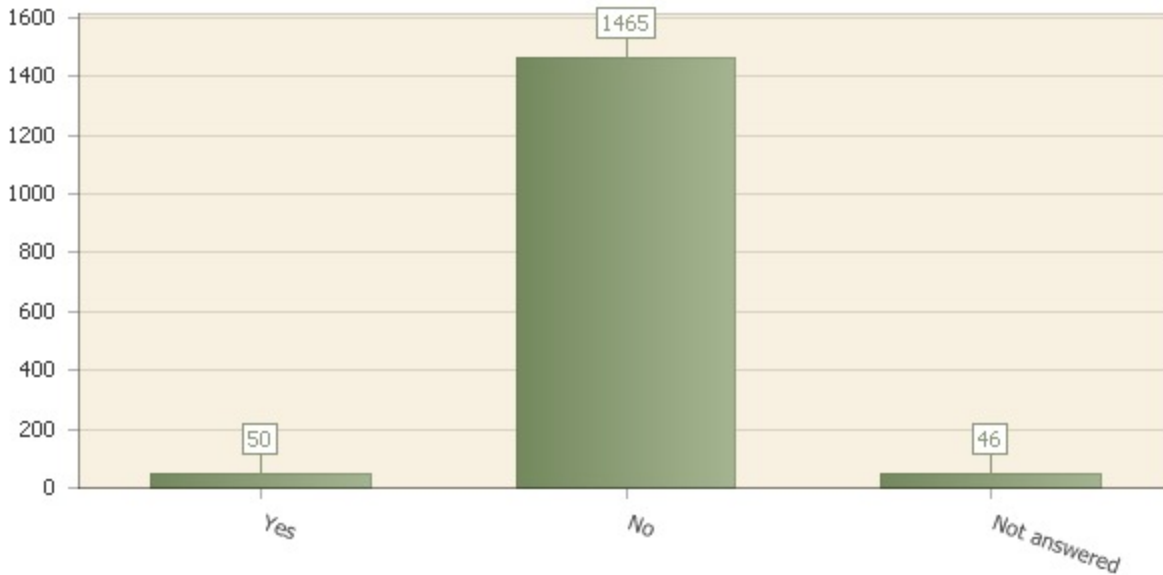

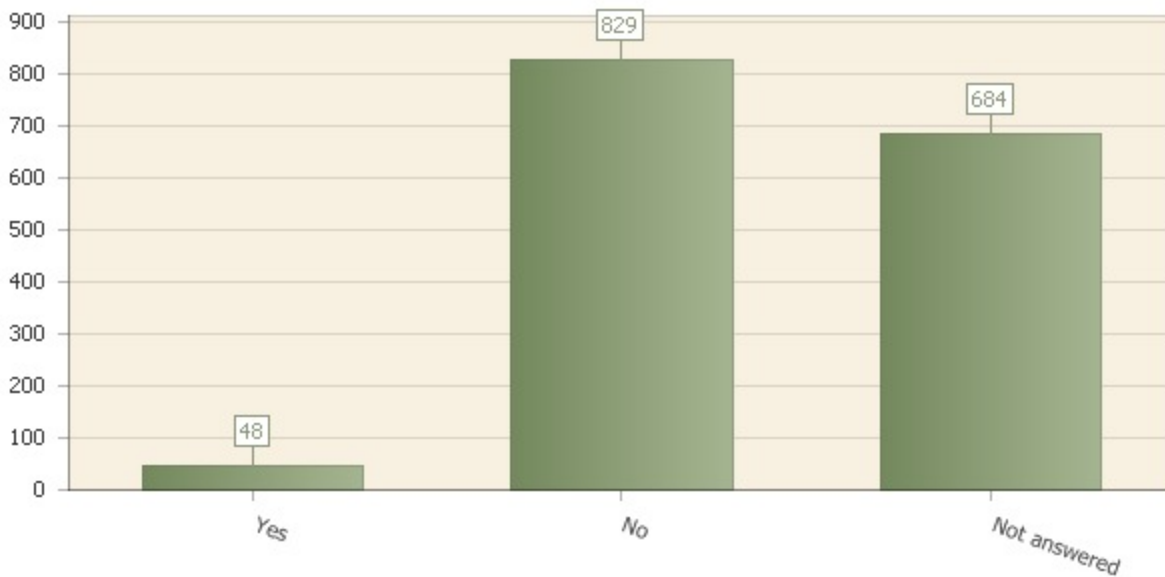

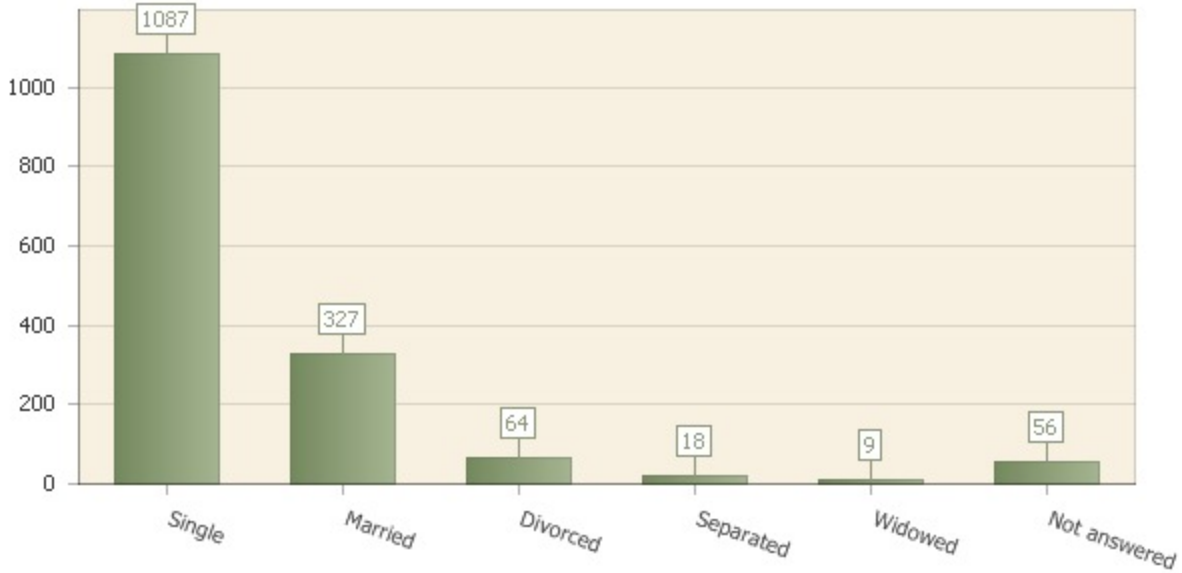

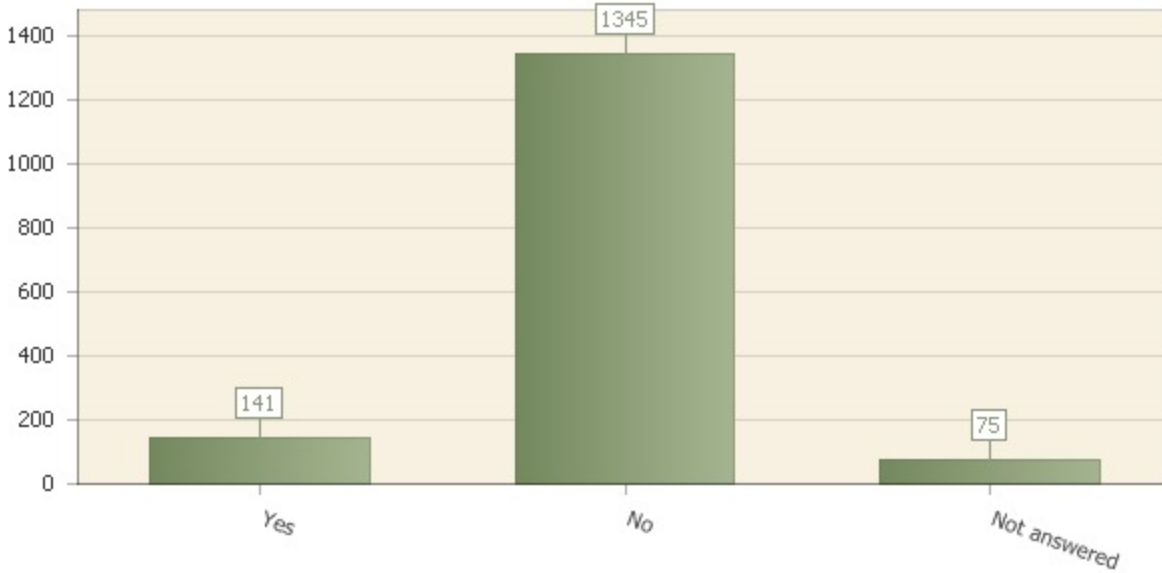

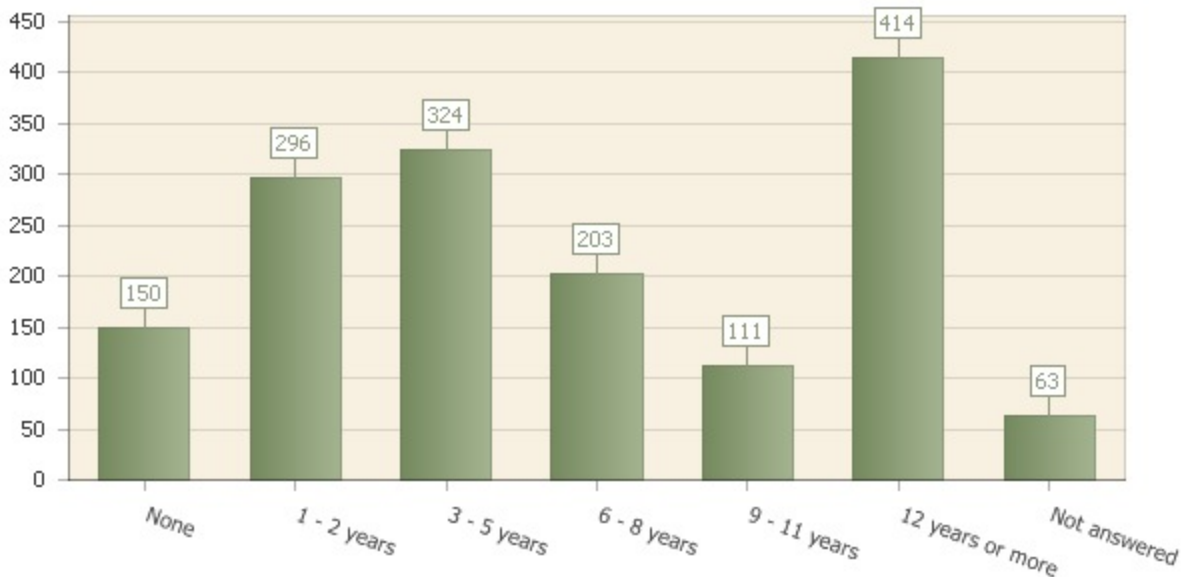

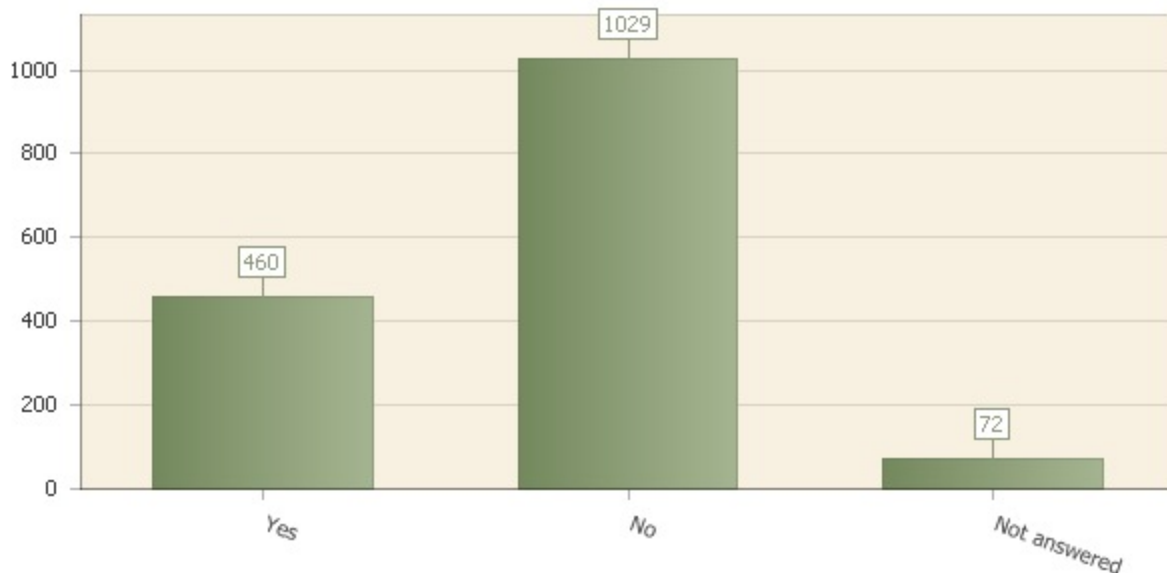

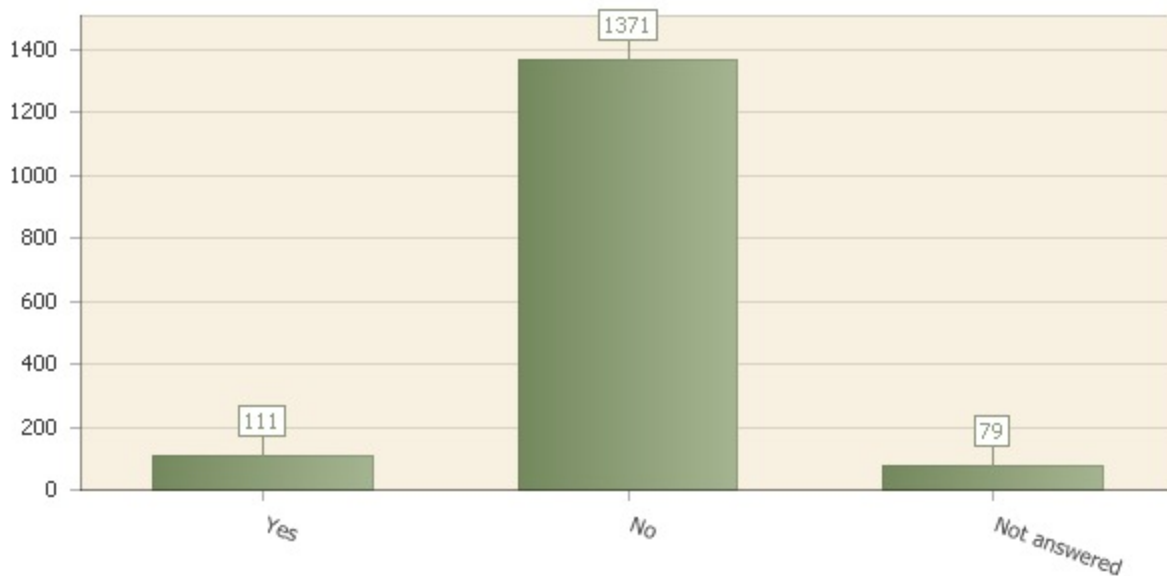

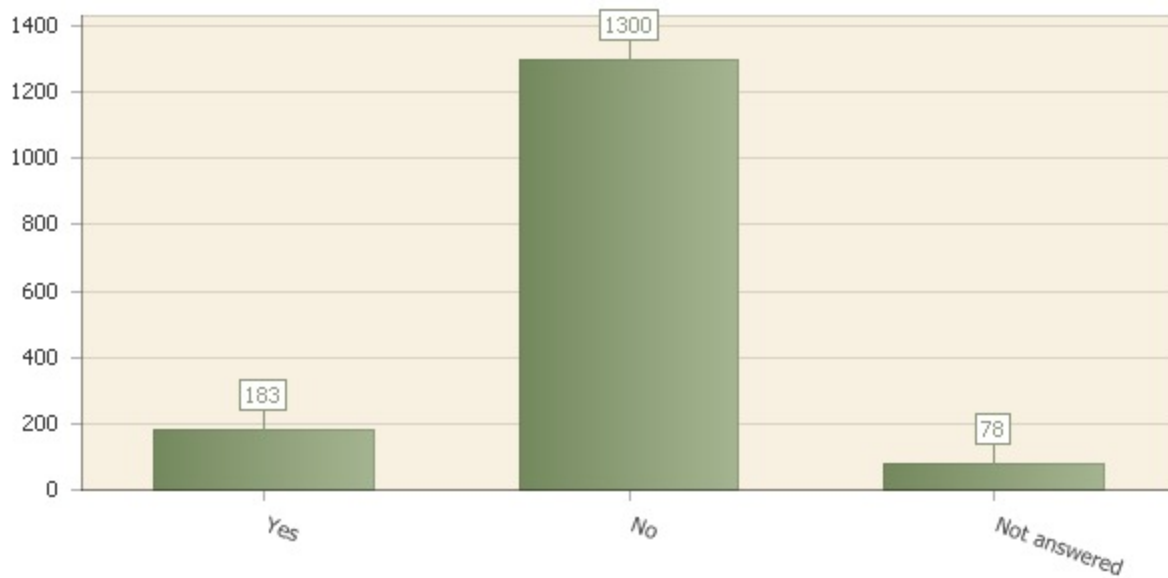
Have you spent more than one year outside of the job market in the last two years?



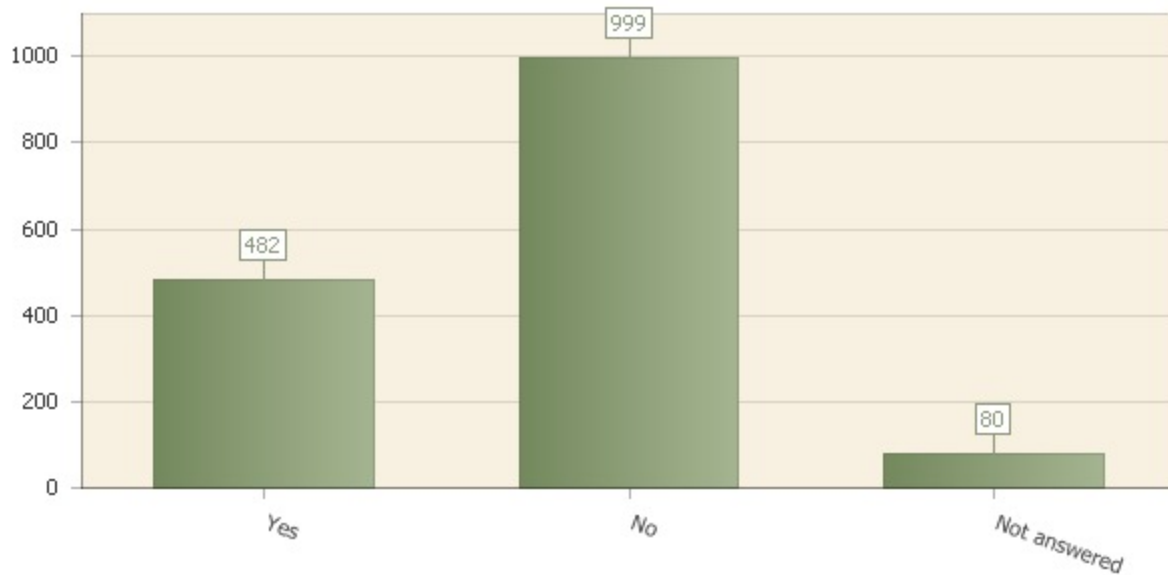
Have you been dependent on the public assistance of a relative (who is no longer able to support you)?



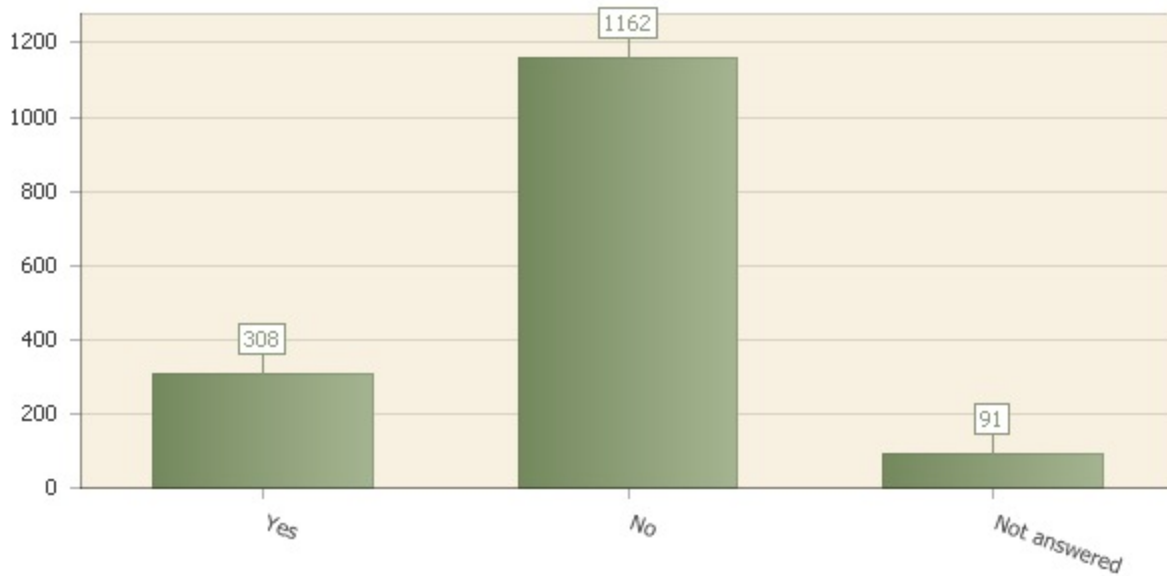

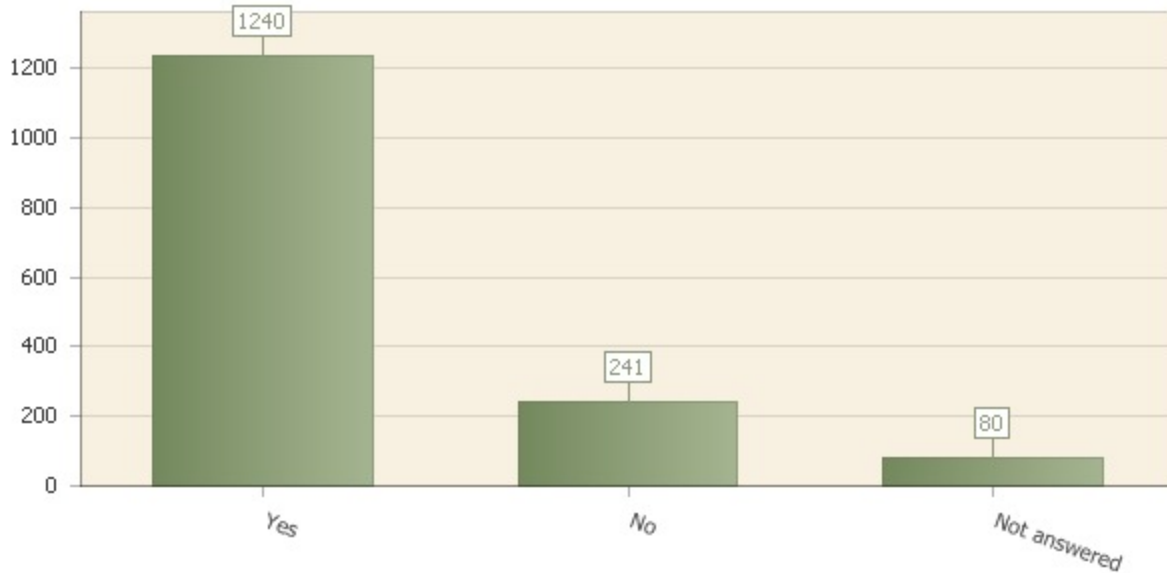

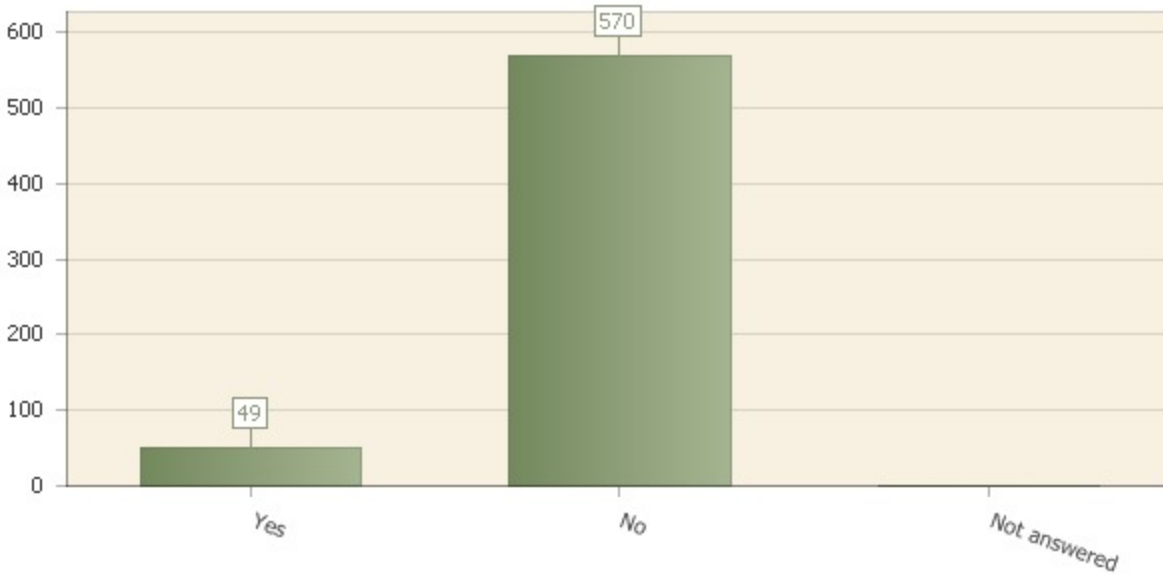

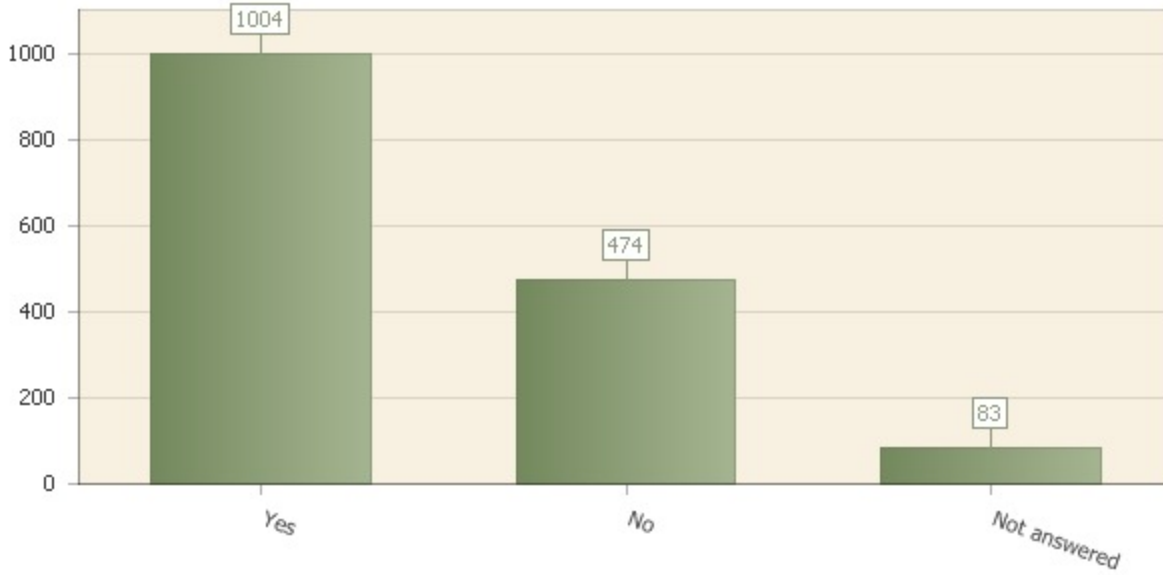

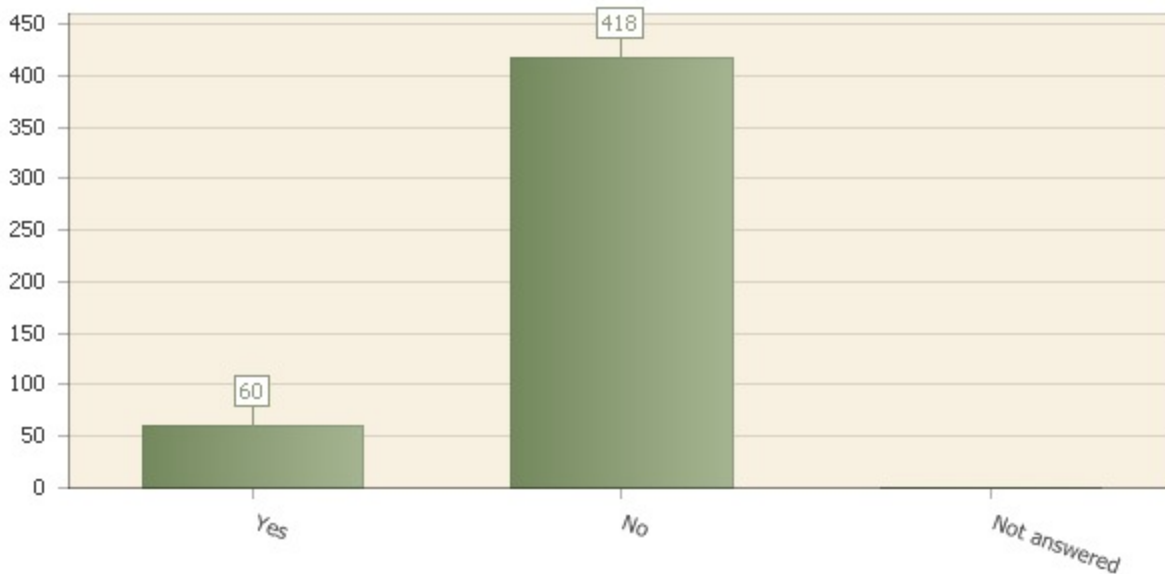

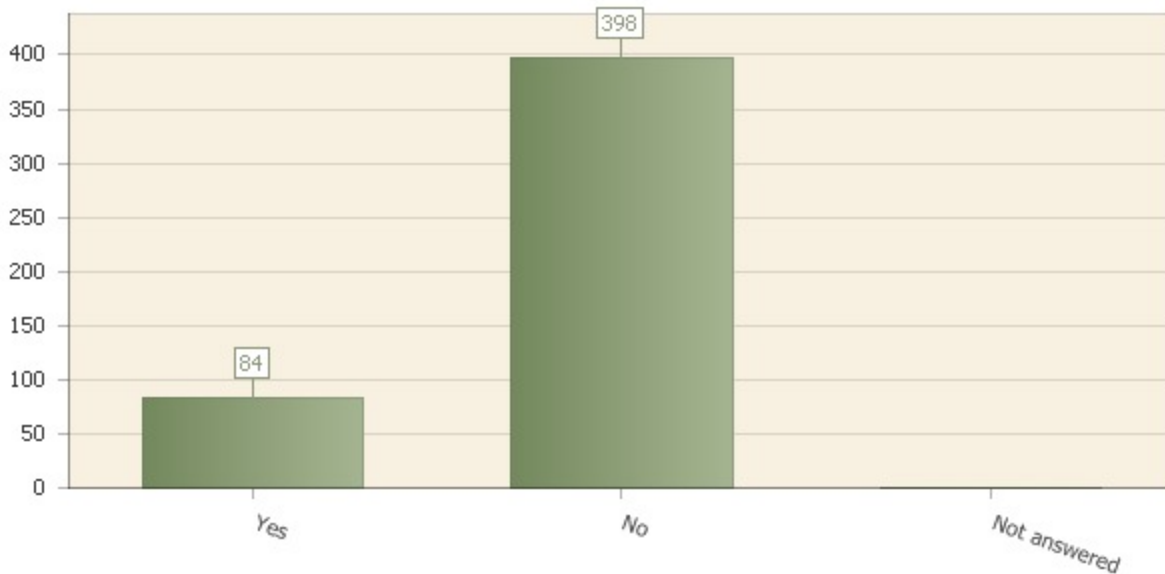
If your answer to Q4 is no, would you like to receive assistance in English?

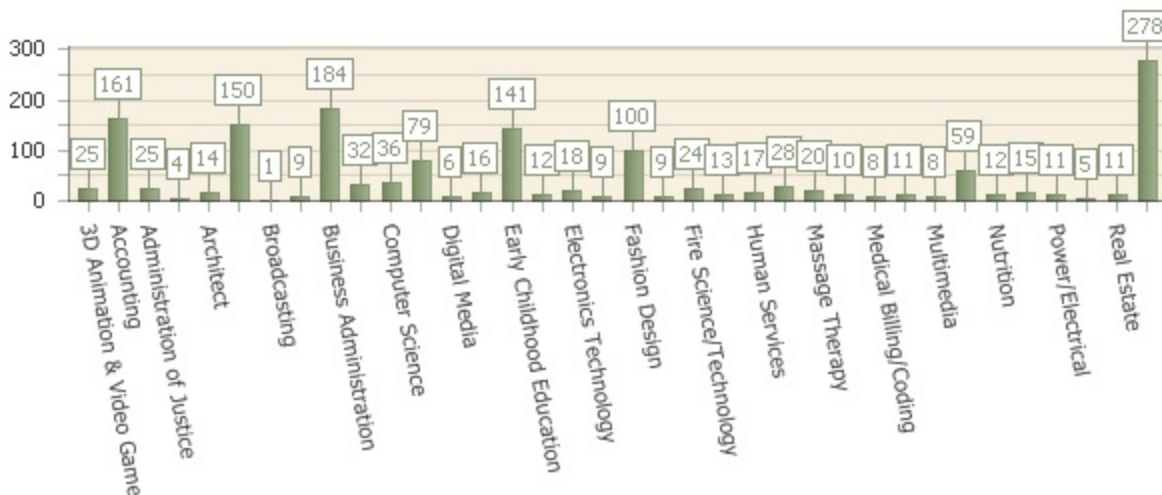
