

Program Effectiveness Data

Program Completion Rate (PCR) – is defined as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length compared with the number of students who initially started with the cohort

ARRT Examination Pass Rate: The number of graduates who pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) compared with the number of graduates whose first attempt take the examination within six months of graduation.

Job Placement Rate: The number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences, within twelve months of graduation, compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

The JRCERT has defined not actively seeking employment as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education.
